

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Authorization to Extend the *Gas Tax Relief Act*.** All levy
3 of excise taxes, automotive surcharges, and mass transit automotive
4 surcharges on liquid fuel *shall* be waived for the remainder of Fiscal Year
5 2024, ending September 30, 2024.

6 **Section 2. Enactment.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.

7 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provisions of this Act or its
8 application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to
9 law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act
10 that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to
11 this end the provisions of this Act are severable.

Section 2. Appropriation. The amount of Seven Million Eight Hundred Twenty-three Thousand Seven Hundred Thirty-five Dollars (\$7,823,735) is hereby appropriated to the Guam Highway Fund from the Fiscal Year 2024 General Fund in excess of the adopted revenue levels.

Section 23. Enactment. This Act shall be effective upon enactment.

Section 34. Severability. If any provisions of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable."

“Section . Every person or business, whether engaged in the wholesale or retail of automotive fuel products and who are no longer subject to the payment of excise taxes, automotive surcharges, and mass transit automotive surcharges on liquid fuel pursuant to this Act, shall submit to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guáhan* and the Director of the Department of Revenue and Taxation a written declaration, under penalty of perjury, declaring that such relief or reduction from the levy of taxes and surcharges herein were in fact not collected from the consumer and are removed from the final cost of liquid fuel products for consumers, and declaring the number of gallons of ~~gas~~ liquid fuel sold per month that were exempt from the liquid fuel tax pursuant to this Act.”
