AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW § 4124(b)(3) OF CHAPTER 4, TITLE 17, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO ADDING SCHOOL AND VILLAGE BEAUTIFICATION AS PART OF THE REQUIREMENT OF STUDENT SERVICE-LEARNING HOURS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that the purpose of the implementation of Service-Learning hours is to promote student involvement within their community and environment. Of the seventy-five (75) required Service-Learning hours, ten (10) hours should be dedicated to

- 1 island/village beautification and ten (10) hours should be dedicated to school campus
- 2 beautification which help promote the actual purpose of Service-Learning hours; and
- 3 requiring students to complete twenty (20) hours of the required seventy-five (75)
- 4 hours of environmental cleanliness allows students to become more aware of their
- 5 impact within their school campus, the community of Guam, and the overall
- 6 environment.
- 7 Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to include ten (10) hours
- 8 of island/village beautification and ten (10) hours of school campus beautification
- 9 as part of the required seventy-five (75) hours of Service-Learning hours.
- Section 2. A new § 4124(b)(3) is hereby added to Chapter 4 of Title 17,
- 11 Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:
- 12 "(3) Beginning with the ninth (9th) grade class of School Year 2023-2024,
- each student is encouraged to complete ten (10) hours of village/island beautification
- and ten (10) hours of school campus beautification, including on-campus gardening
- projects, of the required seventy-five (75) hours of Service-Learning hours. Students
- prior to the ninth (9th) grade class of School Year 2023-2024 shall be exempt from
- 17 this Subsection."
- 18 Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective on September 1,
- 19 2024.
