To add a new Section 1 to the Bill to read:

"Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that given the damage and uncertainty caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, Typhoon Mawar, and other geopolitical issues and hardships that have arisen over the past several years, it is projected to take at least several years for the Territory's visitor industry and for the A.B. Won Pat International Airport Authority, Guam ("GIAA") to achieve the enplanement trajectory and financial stability-through the restoration of operating reserves and capital improvement funds - expected prior to the Covid-19 pandemic. Accordingly, I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the current GIAA concessions are in the best interest of the GIAA and the Territory and an extension of such concessions is in the best interest of GIAA and the Territory.

Section 1. Section 2. Authority to Extend Concession Agreements. The A.B.
