**AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW § 96106 TO CHAPTER 96 OF  
TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO  
REQUIRING THE AVAILABILITY OF AUTOMATED  
EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS AT ALL  
GOVERNMENT OF GUAM OFFICES BY DECEMBER  
31, 2024.**

1           **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2           **Section 1.** A new § 96106 is hereby *added* to Chapter 96 of Title 10, Guam  
3 Code Annotated, to read as follows:

4           “§ 96106. **Requiring the Availability of Automated External**  
5 **Defibrillators at All Government Offices.**

6           (a) Each department and agency of the government of Guam,  
7 inclusive of autonomous and semi-autonomous agencies which have an office  
8 that provides a service to the general community of Guam, shall provide  
9 access to an automated external defibrillator (AED). The AED shall be

1 available during hours that the government offices are open to the public. Each  
2 department or agency may create the provisions for the deployment and use  
3 of AEDs, to include, but not be limited to, the following:

4 (1) the locations and quantities at their facilities of AEDs;

5 (2) the training requirements for staff and volunteers to use  
6 the AEDs;

7 (3) monitoring AEDs to ensure the devices will function  
8 correctly as needed; and

9 (4) security and protection of the AEDs from theft, criminal  
10 mischief (vandalism), and damage or destruction from acts of nature.

11 (b) Access to AEDs, as required by Subsection (a), supra, must be  
12 completed by December 31, 2024. Request for funding shall be included in  
13 the Fiscal Year 2025 Budget Request.”

14 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.

15 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any  
16 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or inorganic, such invalidity shall not  
17 affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without  
18 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are  
19 severable.
