AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GUAM POLICE DEPARTMENT (GPD) TO USE THE UNEXPENDED BALANCE OF THE APPROPRIATION AUTHORIZED IN SECTION 2 OF PUBLIC LAW 35-22 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROCURING AUDIOVISUAL RECORDING EQUIPMENT TO BE USED DURING INTERVIEWS CONDUCTED BY GPD PERSONNEL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* (the Guam Legislature) finds that the current practice of the audiovisual recording of interviews conducted by detectives of the Criminal Investigations Division of the Guam Police Department (GPD) has proven valuable in providing an accurate record of the interaction between detectives and suspects, the protection of rights, and for training purposes. Such recordings protect police officers from false claims of misconduct, protect the rights of suspects, and serve as evidence in further proceedings. *I Liheslatura* (the Legislature) further finds that the expansion of GPD's capability to
record complaints and interviews at the police precinct level would serve to enhance
the benefits of its current system.

5 Section 2. The Guam Police Department (GPD) is hereby authorized to use 6 the unexpended balance of the sum authorized in Section 2 of Public Law 35-22 for 7 the purpose of procuring audiovisual recording equipment to be used during 8 interviews conducted by GPD personnel.
