

**AN ACT TO *AMEND* § 3116 OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 3,
TITLE 16, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
REQUIRING THE DISTRIBUTION OF DRIVER'S
HANDBOOKS TO GUAM PUBLIC AND CHARTER
HIGH SCHOOLS.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Statement.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* recognizes the
3 importance of a learner’s permit and driver’s license to families across Guam
4 including teenagers and young adults who are engaged in after-school sports and
5 academic activities. Securing a learner’s permit and driver’s license is also critical
6 to a student’s participation in apprenticeships and other workforce development
7 programs. Accordingly, *I Liheslatura* intends to provide public high school students
8 with free access to copies of the operator’s handbook published by the Department
9 of Revenue and Taxation.

10 **Section 2.** § 3116 of Article 1, Chapter 3, Title 16, Guam Code Annotated,
11 is *amended* to read:

12 **“§ 3116. Publication.**

13 The Department of Revenue and Taxation is authorized to publish
14 various handbooks, covering the rules and regulations of each class of drivers,
15 and to charge a fee therefore as follows:

19 The Department of Revenue and Taxation shall, in coordination with
20 the Department of Education and Charter Schools and the Guam Public
21 Library System, provide public and charter high school students with access
22 to copies of the operator’s handbook. The handbooks shall be made available
23 and prominently displayed at each public and charter high school and Guam
24 public library and shall be provided as a learning resource at no cost to
25 students. The handbooks shall remain the property of the government of
26 Guam.”

1 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
2 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or inorganic, such invalidity shall not
3 affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
4 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
5 severable.

6 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
