AN ACT TO AMEND § 3116 OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 3, TITLE 16, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO REQUIRING THE DISTRIBUTION OF DRIVER'S HANDBOOKS TO GUAM PUBLIC AND CHARTER HIGH SCHOOLS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

**Section 1. Legislative Statement.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* recognizes the importance of a learner's permit and driver's license to families across Guam including teenagers and young adults who are engaged in after-school sports and academic activities. Securing a learner's permit and driver's license is also critical to a student's participation in apprenticeships and other workforce development programs. Accordingly, *I Liheslatura* intends to provide public high school students with free access to copies of the operator's handbook published by the Department of Revenue and Taxation.

**Section 2.** § 3116 of Article 1, Chapter 3, Title 16, Guam Code Annotated, is *amended* to read:

#### "§ 3116. Publication.

The Department of Revenue and Taxation is authorized to publish various handbooks, covering the rules and regulations of each class of drivers, and to charge a fee therefore as follows:

	(a)	Operator's Handbook	\$ 5.00
7	(b)	Chauffeur's Handbook	\$ 5.00
}	(c)	Motorcycle Handbook	\$ 5.00

The Department of Revenue and Taxation shall, in coordination with the Department of Education and Charter Schools and the Guam Public Library System, provide public and charter high school students with access to copies of the operator's handbook. The handbooks shall be made available and prominently displayed at each public and charter high school and Guam public library and shall be provided as a learning resource at no cost to students. The handbooks shall remain the property of the government of Guam."

- **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or inorganic, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
- **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
