AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW § 8113.15 TO ARTICLE 1 OF CHAPTER 8, TITLE 12, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO PROVIDING TEMPORARY EMERGENCY POWER CAPACITY.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 **Section 1.** A new § 8113.15 is hereby *added* to Article 1 of Chapter 8, Title
- 3 12, Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:
- 4 **"§ 8113.15. Temporary Emergency Power Capacity.**
- 5 The Guam Power Authority (GPA), with all deliberate speed, and with
- 6 the consent of the Guam Public Utilities Commission (GPUC), shall proceed

with the emergency procurement under 5 GCA, Chapter 5, § 5215 for a vendor to provide, install, and operate approximately twenty (20) megawatts of temporary power generation on a two (2)-year base contract. The temporary power generation shall be sited at GPA's existing *Yigo* diesel site, located on Lot 7054-5 in *Yigo*, due to the proximity of existing critical power infrastructure and necessary permits. In view of the urgency for the procurement of temporary emergency power capacity and the length of time the emergency is expected to last, the ninety (90) day limitation on the emergency in 5 GCA, Chapter 5, § 5215(e) is extended to two (2) years for this procurement only and the stay of proceedings in the event of a protest in 5 GCA, Chapter 5, § 5425(g) is hereby waived. The Attorney General of Guam's approval as to the contract's form and legality in 5 GCA, Chapter 5, § 5150 must be completed within five (5) calendar days of receipt of the procurement package from GPA, and GPA is hereby authorized to proceed with the emergency procurement, subject to the approval of the GPUC."

Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or inorganic, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
