AN ACT TO AMEND § 21103 OF CHAPTER 21, TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO REQUIRING SANITARY PERMITS TO BE RENEWED EVERY YEAR ON THE ANNIVERSARY DATE OF ISSUE.

BE IT ENACTEI) BY THE	PEOPLE OF	GUAM:
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2 Section 1. § 21103 of Chapter 21, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, is

- 3 *amended* to read as follows:
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"§ 21103. Form, Duration and Charges for Permit and Annual Renewal.

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The form of the permit shall be prescribed by the Director. All permits applicable thereto shall be issued on an annual basis and, regardless of when issued, shall expire one (1) year after the date for which issued or renewed.

- All permits applicable thereto which are already in existence prior to the enactment of this law shall be renewed on the month consistent with the month they originally attained their permit. The Director shall have up to twelve (12) months from the enactment of this law to amend the renewal dates of these sanitary permits to conform with the renewal date outlined in the Section.
- 10Sanitary permits for the *temporary workforce housing* category, as11defined in Chapter 26A of this Title, shall adhere to the permit renewal12schedule pursuant to 10 GCA § 26A104.
- 13The fee for the sanitary permit shall be determined by the Director by14regulation and shall be collected by him or his designee. The falsification of15an application for a sanitary permit may result in the suspension or revocation16of the sanitary permit in accordance with 10 GCA § 21109."
