

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FOUR HUNDRED FIFTEEN  
THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$415,000) FROM FISCAL YEAR  
2024 GENERAL FUND REVENUES COLLECTED IN  
EXCESS OF THE ADOPTED LEVELS ENUMERATED IN  
PUBLIC LAW 37-42, AS *AMENDED*, TO THE GUAM  
ELECTION COMMISSION FOR THE 2024 GUAM  
PRIMARY ELECTION.**

1        **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2        **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds  
3 that the Bureau of Budget and Management Research (BBMR) sent a letter on April  
4 15, 2024 addressed to Director Maria Pangelinan from the Guam Election  
5 Commission (GEC) regarding funding for the 2024 Primary Election in Guam. In  
6 the letter it noted that although *I Maga'hågan Guåhan* was authorized to provide  
7 GEC with Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000) for the 2024 Primary  
8 Election, there was no specific funding source identified for such authorization.

1            *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* also finds that in the letter it stated that Section 4 of  
2 Chapter I and Section 22 of Chapter 13, both of Public Law 37-42, prohibit *I*  
3 *Maga'hågan Guåhan* from expending the General Fund revenues collected in excess  
4 of the adopted revenues without any legislative appropriation.

5            Thus, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to provide GEC with the  
6 appropriate funding for the 2024 Primary Election.

7            **Section 2. Appropriation.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the  
8 sum of Four Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (**\$415,000**) is hereby appropriated  
9 from Fiscal Year 2024 General Fund revenues collected in excess of the adopted  
10 levels enumerated in Public Law 37-42, as amended, to the Guam Election  
11 Commission for the 2024 Primary Election. This appropriation shall be available  
12 until fully expended. The funds allocated and authorized in this Section are not  
13 subject to *I Maga'hågan Guåhan*'s transfer authority.

14            **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
