AN ACT TO TRANSFER LOT NO. 106-1, BLOCK 12 IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF *INALÅHAN*, FORMERLY KNOWN AS THE *INALÅHAN* BAPTIST CHURCH, TO THE GUAM PRESERVATION TRUST.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
that *Inalåhan* lies along the southeastern shore of Guam and is the largest of the
island's southern villages. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that the village of

Inalåhan stands as a Spanish-style settlement, noting the area to be known as the
 Inalåhan Historic District.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan recognizes the significance of the *Inalåhan* Historic District from the context of its built environment and village fabric defined by tight groupings of small-scale buildings and structures, the narrow streetscape, and architectural themes; and that the *Inalåhan* Historic District represents a unique revitalization opportunity because it possesses a great potential to promote our island of Guam as a cultural tourism destination.

9 The Inalåhan Baptist Church was built in 1925 for a small congregation of 10 General Baptist Church parishioners residing in the southern villages of Guam, and 11 Mr. A.I. Luttrull directed the erection of the church. The significance of the church 12 structure is its contribution to the architectural vernacular of the Historic District of 13 Inalåhan. The architecture of the church depicts the Spanish-style features of 14 massive walls and the mamposteria construction method of lime mortar and stone 15 rubble; and this method of construction is prevalent in *Inalåhan* homes of the period. The church walls are made of mamposteria and it had a metal roof; and like the 16 village houses, the one (1)-room church is elevated, no doubt a practical concept 17 18 considering its close proximity to the bay; and its last service was held in 1960.

19 The Guam Preservation Trust (GPT) continues to preserve and protect our 20 island's historic sites, culture, and perspectives for the benefit of the people of Guam 21 and their future; and through this measure, it is the intent to grant jurisdictional 22 authority to the government of Guam to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement 23 with the Inalåhan Mayor and the Inalåhan Municipal Planning Council as caretaker of the historic site relating to the Inalåhan Baptist Church; and ultimately, a 24 25 Memorandum of Agreement with the Guam Preservation Trust ensures GPT's 26 commitment to their continued efforts to restore, reconstruct, and rehabilitate the

1 Church's front façade structure while still retaining its historical essence and as a 2 venue for religious and fellowship activities.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan intends to authorize the government of Guam to enter 3 4 into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Inalåhan Mayor and the Inalåhan Municipal Planning Council for jurisdictional authority over Lot No. 106-1 Block 5 6 No. 12 in Inalåhan, Guam. The Inalåhan Mayor and the Inalåhan Municipal 7 Planning Council shall then enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Guam 8 Preservation Trust relating to Lot No. 106-1, Block No. 12, formerly known as the Inalåhan Baptist Church, municipality of Inalåhan, Guam, for the purpose of 9 10 stabilizing and restoring its historical structure that has been a public concern for its 11 hazardous state that compromises the safety and well-being of the local residents 12 and the visitors of *Inalåhan* village.

Section 2. Authorization to Enter into a Memorandum of Agreement.

14 The government of Guam is authorized to and shall enter into a Memorandum of 15 Agreement with the Inalåhan Mayor and Inalåhan Municipal Planning Council for 16 jurisdictional authority relative to Lot No. 106-1, Block No. 12, Inalåhan, Guam,

Estate No. 86788, Urban, containing an area of 869.29 square meters (REC.), as 17 shown on Drawing No. 14-84T242, L.M. No. 098- FY 85, prepared by the 18 19 Government of Guam, Department of Land Management, Land Survey Division, 20 dated 04/24/1985, and recorded under Instrument No. 367991, municipality of 21 *Inalåhan* for the purpose of the stabilization and restoration of the *Inalåhan* Baptist 22 Church; provided, that the property shall be managed and maintained and insured in 23 trust for the people of Guam as an historic site according to rules set by the Guam 24 Preservation Trust for the site.

25 I Mina'trentai Siette Na Liheslaturan Guåhan hereby authorizes I 26 Maga'hågan Guåhan to transfer the jurisdictional authority with a Memorandum of Agreement for Lot No. 106-1, municipality of Inalåhan to the Inalåhan Mayor and 27

the *Inalåhan* Municipal Planning Council. The *Inalåhan* Mayor and the *Inalåhan* Municipal Planning Council shall then enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Guam Preservation Trust relating to Lot No. 106-1, formerly known as the *Inalåhan* Baptist Church, municipality of *Inalåhan*, Guam, for the purpose of stabilizing and restoring its historical structure.

6 Section 3. Exemption. § 2107 of Chapter 2, Title 2, Guam Code Annotated,
7 and Section 6.049(c)(1) of *I Mina'trentai Siette Na Liheslaturan Guåhan Otden*8 Areklamento, relative to the appraisals of land, shall not apply to this Act.

9 Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any 10 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or inorganic, such invalidity shall not 11 affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without 12 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are 13 severable.

14 Section 5. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
