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AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE *I MAGA'HÅGAN GUÅHAN* TO UTILIZE UP TO FIFTY MILLION DOLLARS (\$50,000,000) FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR EMERGENCY RESPONSE EXPENSES IN RESPONSE TO TYPHOON *MAWAR*.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 **Section 1. Emergency Expenses.** Notwithstanding any other provision or law, and 3 in addition to the authority granted in 5 GCA §22402 and in Public Law 36-107, I 4 Maga'hågan Guåhan [the Governor] is authorized to utilize up to Fifty Million 5 Dollars (\$50,000,000.00) from the General Fund for emergency response expenses 6 in response to Typhoon Mawar, including but not limited to expenses related to 7 safety and security; food, water, and sheltering; health and medical; energy; 8 communications; transportation; and hazardous materials. Individual Assistance is 9 specifically authorized for use of funds appropriated herein, and I Maga'håga shall 10 coordinate with the Federal Emergency Management Authority and the American 11 Red Cross to compile survey data for the individual assistance determinations. I 12 Maga'håga shall further disburse One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) from 13 the funds appropriated herein to each mayor, who may utilize such monies for the 14 purposes identified above. Mayors shall report any expenditure of funds provided 15 herein to I Maga'håga and I Liheslaturan Guåhan [the Legislature] within thirty

- 1 (30) days after such transactions. I Maga'håga shall provide a written report of the
- 2 any expenditure of funds provided in this Act, other than the expenditures by the
- 3 Mayors, to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the Public Auditor within thirty (30) days
- 4 after such transactions. Appropriations made herein may be expended provided that
- 5 it does not negatively impact the current operational needs of the Executive Branch.
- 6 Section 2. The written report should contain sufficient detail of expenditures to
- 7 qualify for federal reimbursement as allowed through the emergency declaration
- 8 resulting from Typhoon Marwar. The Department of Administration shall work
- 9 with the Office of the Public Auditor to ensure these emergency expenditures are
- 10 reported properly and meet the requirements for reimbursement.
- 11 Section 3. Such reimbursements by the federal government as a result of the
- 12 expenditures allowed herein shall be immediately deposited into the General Fund
- 13 upon receipt by *I Maga'hågan Guåhan*, the Department of Administration or any
- 14 other instrumentality of the government of Guam and shall not be subject to further
- 15 transfer authority.
- 16 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective immediately.
