AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW § 7117 TO CHAPTER 7, TITLE 17, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO ALLOWING THE USE OF EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT PROCEDURES TO ENABLE THE GUAM DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO COMPLY WITH PUBLIC LAW 37-04 IN THE WAKE OF TYPHOON MAWAR.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.
- 3 I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that as a consequence of the damage caused by
- 4 Typhoon Mawar and the use of GDOE schools as storm shelters for those displaced
- 5 by Mawar, a subsequent critical emergency situation was created that may likely
- 6 affect the timelines to get GDOE schools in compliance with the environmental
- 7 health standards required by the Department of Public Health and Social Service.
- 8 Therefore, GDOE is at risk of not being able to open schools in a timely manner or
- 9 comply with the requirements enacted by Public Law 37-04.
- It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to allow GDOE to use the emergency
- procurement law to facilitate purchases required to comply with Public Law 37-04.
- Section 2. A new § 7117 is *added* to Chapter 7, Title 17 Guam Code Annotated
- to read as follows:

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1	"§ 7117. Emergency Procurement for Compliance with Public Law

3	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Guam Department of

7	This Section shall sunset One Hundred Twenty (120) days after the date

"Section 3. Reporting Requirements. The Guam Department of Education shall report all procurements awards to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* within Five (5) days, excluding Saturdays, Sundays and Government of Guam holidays, after the date of award. The report shall include the name of the awardee, the item purchased and services contracted, and the dollar amount of each award, and the information shall be submitted through a sworn or verified certificate indicating the Department of Education complied with applicable procurement rules and regulations."
