

**AN ACT TO *AMEND* § 11115 OF CHAPTER 11, TITLE 3,
GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
TABULATED AND PUBLISHED WRITE-IN VOTES.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** § 11115 of Chapter 11, Title 3, Guam Code Annotated, is
3 *amended* to read as follows:

4 “§ 11115. **Write-in Votes.**

5 If the write-in voting oval or other defined space is marked, a
6 write-in vote shall be counted for the office under which it is marked,
7 provided a name is written alongside the voting oval or other defined
8 space shown. If the total number of write-in votes counted for an
9 office could change the results as to the person having the largest
10 number of votes for that office, the names appearing next to the
11 marked write-in voting oval or other defined space for that office shall
12 be tabulated and published. Otherwise, only the total number of write-
13 in voting ovals or other defined spaces marked shall be tabulated and
14 published.”

15 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.

16 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any

1 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or inorganic, such invalidity shall not
2 affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
3 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
4 severable.
