AN ACT TO PROVIDE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS
FOR THE OPERATIONS OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF
THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING
SEPTEMBER 30, 2007

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

CHAPTER I

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Section 1. Short Title.

This Act shall be known as the "*Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2007*". Except as otherwise provided by this Act, the appropriations made by this Act shall be available to pay for obligations incurred on or after October 1, 2006 but no later than September 30, 2007. In the event that any appropriation of this Act is found contrary to federal law, all portions not so found shall remain valid.

Section 2. Amendment to Section 30 Estimated Revenues for Fiscal Year 2007.

Section 3. Supplemental Appropriation

1 Eighteen Million One Hundred Fifty-four Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-eight
2 (\$18,154,338) are appropriated from the General Fund for the operations of the Executive
3 Branch for fiscal year ending September 30, 2007. The appropriations made by this Act
4 shall be available to pay for obligations incurred on or after October 1, 2006 but no later
5 than September 30, 2007. The appropriation shall be expended as follows:
