## *I MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN* 2015 (FIRST) Regular Session

AN ACT TO AMEND § 41006 OF ARTICLE 10, CHAPTER 4 OF TITLE 12 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, AND TO REPEAL §§ 41004(a)(4) and (5) OF ARTICLE 10, CHAPTER 4 OF TITLE 12 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO ELIMINATING THE CORPORATION THE REOUIREMENT THAT **APPROPRIATE A FIXED AMOUNT OF \$500,000.00 FROM ITS** ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUE TO ENSURE A RESERVE BALANCE OF THE SAME AT THE BEGINNING OF EACH ТО AMENDING THE TIMING FISCAL YEAR. AND **RESPECTING THE ANNUAL AUDIT OF THE HOUSING** TRUST FUND TO COINCIDE WITH THAT OF THE GUAM HOUSING CORPORATION'S ANNUAL AUDIT.

## **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. It is the intent of *I* 3 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* to repeal certain provisions of the Housing Trust Fund statute 4 requiring the Guam Housing Corporation to appropriate Five Hundred Thousand 5 Dollars (\$500,000.00) from its annual operating revenues to ensure that a reserve 6 balance is maintained at the beginning of each fiscal year, and to amend the 7 provisions relating to the timeline on conducting annual audits of the Housing 8 Trust Fund to be consistent with the same time as the Guam Housing Corporation's

1	annual audit-both of which are logistical measures meant to ensure the successful
2	execution by the Guam Housing Corporation's of its critical mandate.
3	Section 2. Section 41006 of Article 10, Chapter 4, 12 Guam Code Annotated
4	is hereby amended to read as follows:
5	"§41006. Annual Audit. "An annual audit shall be conducted on the Fund
6	and shall be submitted to I Maga'låhen Guåhan and the Speaker of I Liheslaturan
7	Guåhan within ninety (90) days after the end of each fiseal year the same period of
8	the GHC's Corporation's annual yearly audit. Such annual audits shall be
9	conducted or cause to be conducted by the Office of Public Accountability. The
10	funding for each annual audit shall be no more than Fifteen Thousand Dollars
11	(\$15,000.00) subject to adjustments made by the Guam Housing Corporation
12	Board of Director funded by GHC in an amount to be approved by the Guam
13	Housing Corporation Board of Directors, and shall be funded by the GHC funded
14	by the GHC in an amount to be approved by the GHC Board of Directors."
15	Section 3. Sections 44101(a)(4) and 441001(a)(5) of Article 10, Chapter 4,
16	12 Guam Code Annotated is hereby repealed:
17	(4) For the fiscal years thereafter, up to Five Hundred Thousand Dollars
18	(\$500,000) is hereby appropriated from the GHC's annual operating and/or non-
19	operating revenues as needed to ensure the reserved balance of the Fund required

in Subsection (6) is at least Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) at the
 beginning of each fiscal year.

(5) If, in the fiscal years thereafter, the GHC's annual operating and/or nonoperating revenues and/or income are not sufficient to provide the funding
necessary to fulfill the requirements set forth in § 41004(a)(4), the difference
between what is required and what is appropriated from the GHC's annual
operating and/or non-operating revenues and/or income, is hereby appropriated
from the GHC's fund balance or its equivalent.

9 Section 4. Severability. The provisions outlined in this Act are declared to 10 be separate and severable. The invalidity of any clause, sentence, paragraph, 11 subdivision, section or portion of this statute, or the invalidity of the application 12 thereof to any person or circumstance shall not affect the validity of the remainder 13 of this statute or the validity of its application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 5. Effective Date. The provisions outlined in this Act shall become
effective upon enactment.
