AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW SUBSECTION (yy) TO § 1102 OF CHAPTER 1, TITLE 16, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, AND TO *AMEND* § 26104(c) OF CHAPTER 26, TITLE 16 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO ADDING LIMOUSINES TO DEFINITIONS AND EXEMPTIONS.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** A *new* Subsection (yy) to § 1102. Definitions of Chapter 1,
3 Title 16 Guam Code Annotated is hereby *added* to read:

4 “(yy) A limousine is any motorized vehicle, of either standard or
5 extended length, with a seating capacity of not more than ten (10)
6 passengers, including the driver, used for hire in the transportation of
7 passengers on a prearranged basis within the territory and as indicated on the
8 “Motor Vehicle Registration” as issued by the Department of Revenue &
9 Taxation. Additionally, the registered owner must have been issued a
10 Business License for “Transportation Service”.”

11 **Section 2.** § 26104. Exemptions, subparagraph (c) of Chapter 26
12 Passenger Restraint Devices, Title 16 Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *amended*
13 to read:

14 “(c) The inadequately restrained individual is a passenger of an
15 emergency, passenger transport vehicle, limousine or taxicab. As used in this
16 Section, *unless* the context otherwise requires:

1 (1) *Emergency vehicle* means an on-duty official ambulance,
2 official firefighting vehicle, official rescue vehicle, or official law
3 enforcement vehicle;

4 (2) *Passenger transport vehicle* means any vehicle operated to
5 carry passengers en masse with:

6 (A) gross vehicle weight rating of over ten thousand
7 (10,000) pounds;

8 (B) that is specified on the vehicle's federal
9 certification label by the manufacturer as any type of bus; or

10 (C) that is classified as a bus, or issued a bus license
11 plate, by the Department of Revenue and Taxation;

12 (3) *Taxicab* means any vehicle being licensed, operated *or*
13 maintained for the transportation of persons for hire, compensation or
14 profit, with a gross vehicle rating *under* ten thousand (10,000) pounds.

15 (4) A limousine means any motorized vehicle, of either
16 standard or extended length, with a seating capacity of not more than
17 ten (10) passengers including the driver, used for hire in the
18 transportation of passengers on a prearranged basis within the territory
19 and as indicated on the "Motor Vehicle Registration" as issued by the
20 Department of Revenue & Taxation. Additionally, such companies
21 must have been issued a Business License for "Transportation
22 Service".

23 **Section 3. Severability.** *If any of the provisions of this law or its application to*
24 *any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such*
25 *invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this law which can be*
26 *given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the*
27 *provisions of this law are severable.*
