AN ACT AMEND § 3201.1(a) OF CHAPTER 3, DIVISION 1, TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, TO PROVIDE FOR THE QUALIFICATIONS OF THE TERRITORIAL EPIDEMIOLOGIST OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Subsection (a) of § 3201.1, Chapter 3 of Division 1, Title 10,
Guam Code Annotated, is *amended* to read:

"(a) There is hereby established within the Department of Public Health and 4 Social Services ('DPHSS') a Guam Cancer Registry, which shall operate under the 5 supervision of the Division of Public Health, Office of Epidemiology and 6 Research, to collect information on all cases of cancer occurring within Guam, to 7 analyze and compare such data in appropriate ways and to annually prepare and 8 distribute a report on their findings. The Territorial Guam Epidemiologist shall be 9 a Guam-licensed physician or a graduate from an American Medical Association 10 approved medical school with a M.D. degree and certification by the American 11 Board of Prevention Medicine, or graduation from a recognized school of public 12 health with a M.P.H. degree (epidemiology major) from an accredited school with 13 a graduate degree in epidemiology or biostatistics and 1-2 years of experience in 14 the field of epidemiology a licensed veterinarian." 15

16 Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to 17 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be
given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the
provisions of this Act are severable.
