AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE FY 2014 FUND BALANCE OF THE TOURIST ATTRACTION FUND FOR THE PAYMENT OF OPERATIONAL NEEDS OF THE 2016 FESTIVAL OF THE PACIFIC ARTS ACTIVITIES, PAYMENTS TO THE EMPLOYEES OF THE GOVERNEMNT OF GUAM RESULTING FROM THE ENACTMENT OF THE COMPETITIVE WAGE ACT, AND TO FUND THE BALANCEOF PAYMENTS DUE TO LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that the sum of Four Million Four Hundred Ninety-Four Thousand Nine Hundred
4 Sixty-Nine Dollars (**\$4,494,969**) from the unappropriated, unallocated fund
5 balance of the FY 2014 Tourist Attraction Fund (TAF) is available for
6 appropriation.

7 **Section 2. Appropriation.** Notwithstanding any provision of law, the
8 sum of Four Million Four Hundred Ninety-Four Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-
9 Nine Dollars (**\$4,494,969**) is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated,
10 unallocated fund balance of the FY 2014 Tourist Attraction Fund for the following:

11 (a) Two Million Dollars (**\$2,000,000**) to fund various activities of the
12 2016 Festivals of the Pacific Arts; and

1 (b) Two Million Four Hundred Ninety Four Thousand Nine Hundred
2 Sixty-Nine Dollars (**\$2,494,969**) to fund payments due to
3 Government of Guam employees resulting from the enactment of
4 the Competitive Wage Act and the unpaid balance of base pay
5 adjustments due to Law Enforcement Officers pursuant to §55102
6 of Chapter 55, Title 10 of the Guam Code Annotated.

7 **Section 3. Severability.** If a provision of this act or its application to any
8 person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other
9 provisions or applications of this act that can be given effect without the invalid
10 provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are severable.
