## AN ACT TO AMEND §7117 OF 16GCA RELATIVE TO REQUIRING THE ISSUE OF SALVAGE TITLE CERTIFICATES OF OWNERSHIP FOR VEHICLES TRANSFERRED TO INSURANCE COMPANIES AS A RESULT OF PAYMENT OF CLAIMS FOR TOTAL LOSS.

## **1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

3 Section 1. Section 7117 of 16GCAis *amended* to read as follows:

## 5 §7117. Certificate: Contents.

6 (a) The certificate of ownership shall contain upon the face thereof the identical7 information required upon the face of the registration card.

8 (b) The certificate of ownership shall contain upon the reverse side, forms for 9 notice to the Department of a transfer of the title or interest of the owner or legal 10 owner and application for such transfer by the transferee.

11 (c) The certificate of ownership of a vehicle where title is acquired by an insurance

12 company as a result of payment of an insurance claim shall prominently display the

13 words "Salvage Title" on said certificate. The words "Salvage Title" shall remain

14 on the certificate title in perpetuity for all successive owners of said vehicle or any

15 secondary vehicle from which said vehicle's chassis or parts of said vehicle's

16 chassis is used to repair, replace or refurbish the secondary vehicle.

3 Revenue and Taxation when transferring ownership is a civil violation and subject to a fine of not less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500). For purposes of this 4 subsection, salvage refers to any vehicle for which an insurance company has 5 deemed not economically feasible to repair. 6 (d) An insurance company that obtains ownership by payment of a claim for the 7 8 full insured value of a vehicle shall obtain a salvage title certificate of ownership. 9 within ten (10) days of the payment of such claim (weekends and government of Guam holidays excepted), from the Department of Revenue and taxation prior to 10 selling or otherwise disposing of the vehicle. The Department of Revenue and 11 Taxation may charge said insurance company a fee not to exceed Three Dollars 12 (\$3.00). Subsequent sales or transfers of a vehicle with a salvage title shall be 13 subject to a fee of Twenty Five Dollars (\$25). Fee revenues herein shall be 14 deposited in the Better Public Service Fund and are continually appropriated the 15 16 Motor Vehicle Division of the Department of Revenue and Taxation. (e) In the event that an insurance company pays a claim for the full insured value 17 of a vehicle and allows the insured to retain ownership of the vehicle, the insurance 18 company shall, within ten (10) days of the payment of such claim (weekends and 19 government of Guam holidays excepted) notify the Motor Vehicle Division of the 20 Department of Revenue and Taxation of such claim. Subsequent transfers of 21 ownership of said vehicles, supra, this subsection shall be issued a salvage title 22 certificate of ownership. 23 (f) A vehicle that receives a salvage title certificate of ownership may be registered 24 for use on Guam's public roadways provided that such vehicle is deemed safe for 25 use on public roads by a manufacturer authorized repair shop. 26

Failure to disclose such insurance claim information, supra, to the Department of
