AN ACT TO AMEND PUBLIC LAW 22-18 TO TRANSFER THIRTY-FIVE (35) ACRES OF LOT 10122-R18, MUNICIPALITY OF DEDEDO RESERVED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR THE AS-TUMBO MIDDLE SCHOOL TO THE CHAMORRO LAND TRUST COMMISSION FOR RESIDENTIAL AND AGRICULTURAL LEASING

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*finds that in 1993 Public Law 22-18 reserved 35 acres of Lot 10122-R18,
Municipality of Dededo for the Guam Department of Education to construct the
As-Tumbo Middle School on said lot.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that in school year 2008-2009 the Guam
 Department of Education opened the newly constructed As-Tumbo Middle School
 comprising of approximately 23 acres, built in the As-Tumbo area, on Block 26 NEW-2, Tract 240, Municipality of Dededo.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan intends to transfer the 35 acres of Lot 10122-R18, Dededo reserved by the Guam Department of Education for the As-Tumbo Middle School under Public Law 22-18 to the Chamorro Land Trust Commission for residential and agricultural leasing.

Section 2. Property Transfer. Thirty-Five Acres (35) of Lot 10122-R18,
 Municipality of Dededo reserved for the As-Tumbo Middle School, previously

proposed under Public Law 22-18, shall be transferred to the Chamorro Land Trust
 Commission to be added into the Chamorro Land Trust Commission Lands
 Inventory for residential and agricultural leasing.

Section 3. Exemption. § 2107 of Title 2, Guam Code Annotated and the
Standing Rules of *I Mina' Trentai Tres Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* relative to the
appraisals of land *shall not* apply to this Act.

Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this law or its application to any
person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this law, which can be given
effect without the invalid provisions or applications and to this end the provisions
of this act are severable.
