**AN ACT TO AMEND §77302 OF ARTICLE 3, CHAPTER 77 OF
TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
EXTENDING THE DUTIES OF THE GUAM POLICE
DEPARTMENT COMMUNITY ASSISTED POLICING
EFFORT (CAPE) VOLUNTEERS TO INCLUDE EVENT
SUPERVISION OF THE 12TH FESTIVAL OF PACIFIC ARTS
(FESTPAC).**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. §77302 of Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby**
3 ***amended, to read as follows :***

4 **“§77302. Volunteers.** Pursuant to §3401.1 (h) of Article 4, Chapter 3 of
5 Title 16. Guam Code Annotated, the Chief of Police is authorized to recruit
6 volunteers to assist the Guam Police Department in the enforcement of the
7 accessible parking and littering laws. In addition to these duties, the Chief of

1 Police shall authorize the use of volunteers to patrol the school campuses of the
2 Guam Department of Education during non-school hours. The volunteers shall
3 take no enforcement action during their patrol of the school campuses, and shall
4 notify the police of suspicious activity or crimes in progress. The Superintendent
5 of Education shall cooperate with the Chief of Police to implement this Section.

6 The Chief of Police is further authorized to recruit volunteers to assist the
7 Guam Police Department with traffic direction, security, and crowd control for
8 events such as, but not limited to, the Guam Ko'ko Road Race, the Guam
9 Micronesian Island Fair, ~~and~~ the Liberation Day Parade, and the 12th Festival of
10 Pacific Arts (FestPac), volunteers are required to obtain a certificate from the Chief
11 of Police demonstrating the completion of a required course of instruction and
12 training that includes training relative to traffic direction and crowd control.”
