AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 3219 (c) OF CHAPTER 3 OF TITLE 16 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED TO AMEND THE NOTICE REQUIREMENT FOR THE SALE OF USED TIRES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslatura Guahan finds
- 3 that Public Law 32-214 updated the standards for sale of used tires. In order to
- 4 further clarify the notice requirements for the statutory mandated standards,
- 5 Liheslatura finds that the notice language should be revised to reflect the changes
- 6 in the standards approved by Public Law 32-214.
- 7 Section 2. Section 3219 (c) of Chapter 3, Title 16 of the Guam Code
- 8 Annotated is amended to read:
- 9 "c) Each retailer, wholesaler and distributor of tires on Guam shall, at the place of
- 10 sale, post in a conspicuous location, in letters at least two (2) inches tall, a
- statement that indicates the dangers of aged tires. The statement shall be printed as
- 12 follows:

- 13 WARNING AGED TIRES CAN FAIL IN USE, CAUSING LOSS OF
- 14 VEHICLE CONTROL, AND PERSONAL INJURY. TIRES DETERIORATE
- 15 WITH AGE, EVEN WITH LITTLE OR NO USE. TIRES OLDER THAN SIX
- 16 (6) TEN 10 YEARS MAY NOT BE SOLD OR MOUNTED FOR USE ON
- 17 VEHICLES OPERATED ON THE HIGHWAYS AND ROADWAYS OF GUAM.
