AN ACT TO PLACE TRACT 3620 (FORMERLY LOT 381-2, MUNICIPALITY OF INARAJAN) UNDER THE ADMINISTRATIVE JURISDICTION OF THE OFFICE OF THE MAYOR OF INARAJAN AND THE INARAJAN MUNICIPAL PLANNING COUNCIL.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Administrative Jurisdiction. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, rule or regulation, a portion of Tract 3620 (formerly lot 381-2), Municipality of Inarajan, Guam is hereby transferred to the Office of the Mayor of Inarajan and the Inarajan Municipal Planning Council for the purpose of constructing a multi-purpose sports facility. Tract 3620 is described in Department of Land Management map drawing reference number 150-FY85/14-85T246 as shown on Exhibit A. Said administrative jurisdiction and shall become effective upon the enactment of this Act.

**Section 2. Property Transfer.** Should the remainder portion of Tract 3620 be no longer required for the construction of a multi-purpose sports facility, it shall automatically transfer to the inventory of the Chamorro Land Trust Commission.

Section 3. Responsibilities of the Department of Land Management. The Department of Land Management shall cause a re-survey of Tract 3620 as described in Department of Land Management map drawing reference number 150-FY85/14-85T246 to sever out the portions of Tract 3620 upon which the Senior Citizens Center and the Inarajan Fire Station are situated on. The remaining portion is the portion that will be

- administratively transferred to the Office of the Mayor of Inarajan and the Inarajan

- 3 Section 4. Exemption. § 2107 of Title 2, Guam Code Annotated and the
- 4 Standing Rules of I Mina' Trentai Tres Na Liheslaturan Guåhan relative to the
- 5 appraisals of land *shall not* apply to this Act.
- 6 **Section 5. Severability.** *If* any provision of this Law or its application to any
- 7 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall *not*
- 8 affect other provisions or applications of this Law which can be given effect without the
- 9 invalid provisions or applications, and to this end the provisions of the Law are
- 10 severable.
