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AN ACT TO REPEAL AND REENACT SECTION §6235 (d) OF ARTICLE 2 OF CHAPTER 6, TITLE 4, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED. RELATIVE TO CLARIFYING THE NUMBER OF ALLOWED CERTIFICATION PAY INCENTIVE TO **GOVERNMENT OF GUAM LINE EMPLOYEES WHO HAVE OBTAINED** CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT. CERTIFIED GOVERNMENT FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT, FRAUD CERTIFIED **EXAMINER.** AND CERTIFIED INTERNAL AUDITOR CERTIFICATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 2. Section 6235 (d) of Chapter 6 of Title 4, Guam Code Annotated is hereby repealed and reenacted to read:

- 4 (d) Certification Pay Differential, Established.
- (1) All Government of Guam line employees, the Office of Public
 Accountability, the University of Guam, and the Guam Department
 of Education employees who have obtained a nationally recognized
 certification as a Certified Public Accountant (CPA), or a Certified
 Government Financial Manager (CGFM), or a Certified Fraud
 Examiner (CFE), or a Certified Internal Auditor (CIA), *shall* be
 entitled to receive a single certification pay differential.
- (2) The Pay differential *shall* be applicable *only* to Single certification
 accomplished by the employee, whichever is higher, and will be

1	processed based on only one of the following, depending on the
2	highest certification accomplished:
3	(a) A Guam licensed CPA <i>shall</i> be eligible to receive a fifteen
4	percent (15%) increase; or,
5	(b) The CGFM, CFE, and CIA, which are nationally recognized
6	but not required to be Guam licensed, shall be eligible to
7	receive a ten percent (10%) increase; or,
8	(c) If the employee has a Guam licensed CPA prior to the
9	enactment of this Act, section (2)(a) of this Subsection shall
10	be applicable <i>only</i> .
11	(3) The pay differential <i>shall</i> apply and is limited to a single
12	certification, and shall not be used in any calculation of the rate of
13	pay with respect to overtime, and shall not be considered pay or
14	compensation in any calculation of enhanced compensation
15	otherwise provided by law.
16	(4) The employee salary <i>must</i> commensurate with the currently
17	approved Government of Guam pay/wage scale. Any deviation
18	from the currently approved Government of Guam pay plan shall
19	not qualify for the differential in this act.
20	(5) The Director of Administration and the President of the University
21	of Guam shall implement a single certification pay differential for
22	all the CPA, CGFM, CFE, and CIA, who are active in their area of
23	certification. Accounting, Auditing, Budgeting and Management

professionals who have a national or Guam Board certification, *shall*be entitled to the certification pay differential provided in Item (1)
of this Subsection, calculated at the rates above, added to the base
pay to rectify an inequity in certification pay.

Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any
person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall
not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect
without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this
Act are severable.
