AN ACT TO AMEND § 54102 OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER
54, DIVISION 5, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED,
RELATIVE TO PRIORITIZING IMPROVEMENTS TO
GUAM'S ROADWAYS.

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1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. § 54102 of Article 1, Chapter 54, Division 5, Title 5, Guam
3 Code Annotated, is hereby *amended*, to read:

4 “§ 54102. Territorial Highway Fund.

5 (a) For the purpose of securing for the entire Territory proper
6 maintenance and construction of existing highways, including roads
7 and city and village streets and for implementing all highway-safety
8 related plans, programs and projects, there is hereby established a
9 fund to be known as the Territorial Highway Fund, which fund to be
10 maintained separate and apart from any other funds of the government
11 of Guam, and independent records shall be kept in connection
12 therewith.

13 (1) Beginning with the General Appropriations Act of
14 2018, no less than one percent (1%) of the government of
15 Guam's General Fund revenues shall be appropriated via the
16 Territorial Highway Fund to the Department of Public Works,

1 annually, for the specific purpose of purchasing asphalt and
2 related construction materials, equipment, and supplies
3 necessary to repair and/or rehabilitate Guam's highways,
4 including roads and city and village streets. Projects shall
5 reflect priorities identified in the Guam Transportation Master
6 Plan 2030 and the Village Streets Master Plan. Funds shall not
7 be used for personnel."

9 **Section 2. Reporting Requirement.** The Director of the Department of
10 Public Works shall submit a report no later than on the sixth month following
11 enactment of this Act, and every six (6) months thereafter, to the Speaker of *I*
12 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* and to *I Maga'låhen Guåhan* detailing all expenditures made
13 pursuant to the requirements of this Act.

15 **Section 3. Severability.** *If* any provision of this Act or the application to
16 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such
17 invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be
18 given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
19 provisions of this Act are severable.
