AN ACT TO AMEND §7117 OF 16GCA RELATIVE TO REQUIRING THE ISSUE OF SALVAGE TITLE CERTIFICATES OF OWNERSHIP FOR VEHICLES TRANSFERRED TO INSURANCE COMPANIES AS A RESULT OF PAYMENT OF CLAIMS FOR TOTAL LOSS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 **Section 1.** Section 7117 of 16GCAis *amended* to read as follows:

4 §7117. Certificate: Contents.

- 5 (a) The certificate of ownership shall contain upon the face thereof the identical
- 6 information required upon the face of the registration card.
- 7 (b) The certificate of ownership shall contain upon the reverse side, forms for
- 8 notice to the Department of a transfer of the title or interest of the owner or legal
- 9 owner and application for such transfer by the transferee.
- 10 (c) The certificate of ownership of a vehicle where title is acquired by an insurance
- 11 company as a result of payment of an insurance claim shall prominently display the
- words "Salvage Title" on said certificate. The words "Salvage Title" shall remain
- on the certificate title in perpetuity for all successive owners of said vehicle or any
- 14 secondary vehicle from which said vehicle's chassis or parts of said vehicle's
- chassis is used to repair, replace or refurbish the secondary vehicle.

- Failure to disclose such insurance claim information, *supra*, to the Department of
- 18 Revenue and Taxation when transferring ownership is a civil violation and subject

- to a fine of not less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500). For purposes of this
- 2 subsection, salvage refers to any vehicle for which an insurance company has
- 3 deemed not economically feasible to repair.
- 4 (d) An insurance company that obtains ownership by payment of a claim for the
- 5 full insured value of a vehicle shall obtain a salvage title certificate of ownership,
- 6 within ten (10) days of the payment of such claim (weekends and government of
- 7 Guam holidays excepted), from the Department of Revenue and taxation prior to
- 8 selling or otherwise disposing of the vehicle. The Department of Revenue and
- 9 Taxation may charge said insurance company a fee not to exceed Three Dollars
- 10 (\$3.00). Subsequent sales or transfers of a vehicle with a salvage title shall be
- subject to a fee of Twenty Five Dollars (\$25). Fee revenues herein shall be
- deposited in the Better Public Service Fund and are continually appropriated the
- 13 Motor Vehicle Division of the Department of Revenue and Taxation.
- 14 (e) In the event that an insurance company pays a claim for the full insured value
- of a vehicle and allows the insured to retain ownership of the vehicle, the insurance
- 16 company shall, within ten (10) days of the payment of such claim (weekends and
- 17 government of Guam holidays excepted) notify the Motor Vehicle Division of the
- 18 Department of Revenue and Taxation of such claim. Subsequent transfers of
- ownership of said vehicles, *supra*, this subsection shall be issued a salvage title
- 20 certificate of ownership.
- 21 (f) A vehicle that receives a salvage title certificate of ownership may be registered
- for use on Guam's public roadways provided that such vehicle is deemed safe for
- use on public roads by a manufacturer authorized <u>licensed</u> repair shop.
