AN ACT TO AMEND §715 ITEM 12 SUBSECTION (m) OF CHAPTER 7 TITLE 1, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO THE GUAM PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM'S USE OF EASTER AND CHRISTMAS BREAKS AS MAKE-UP DAYS IN THE SCHOOL CALENDAR.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings. I Mina Trentai Tres Na Liheslaturan 1 Guahan finds that many school districts within the United States address the issue 2 of lost school days due to inclement weather and other causes by 3 incorporating designated inclement weather make-up days into the school calendar 4 instead of arbitrarily shortening scheduled Christmas and Easter breaks, thus 5 disrupting the plans of the educators and the families of students for off-island 6 travel during those periods. Inasmuch as the public school system is constrained 7 by only a minimum requirement of one hundred eighty (180) instructional days 8 that have to be completed within (thirty) 30 days following the end of the 9 calendared school year, the Guam Public School System clearly has the flexibility 10 to adopt a similar system as is the case in other jurisdictions. - 5 Annotated, "Words and Terms Defined: Significance of Words," is amended to

- 7 "(m) at least one hundred eighty (180) instructional days including make-up
- 8 <u>days</u> each school year with school years ending no later than thirty (30) days
- 9 following the end of the calendared school year. Scheduled Easter and
- 10 Christmas breaks shall not be included in make-up days; and
