AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER V, PART II, SECTION LAW 29-19, RELATIVE OF **PUBLIC** AUTHORIZING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM RETIREMENT FUND FOR PAYMENTS TO CURRENT RETIREES FOR THE REMAINDER OF FISCAL YEAR 2008 FOR GROUP HEALTH, DENTAL AND LIFE **INSURANCE** PREMIUMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that
- an adjustment must be made to the current appropriation to the Government of Guam
- 4 Retirement Fund to ensure that current retirees can continue with medical and dental
- 5 services as provided for in Public Law 29-19. The shortfall is attributed to the

- following: (1) the current exclusion of savings attributable to autonomous agencies as
- well as the Legislative and Judicial branches; and (2) the Actuary's overestimation of
- 3 the active members' cost savings and the underestimation of the retirees' cost
- 4 increase.

- Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to amend Public Law 29-19
- 6 to reflect the correct appropriation to the current provisions as it relates to group
- 7 insurance for current retirees for health, dental and life insurance premiums.

Section 2. Chapter V, Part II Section 1(f) of Public Law 29-19 is hereby

- amended to read:
- 10 "(f) The sum of Fifteen Million Eight Hundred Twenty Three Thousand One
- Hundred Ninety Four Dollars (\$15,823,194) is appropriated from the General Fund to
- the Government of Guam Retirement Fund to pay the following two (2) items for
- current retirees for Fiscal Year 2008:
- 14 (1) Retiree group health, dental and life insurance premiums (to continue
- existing programs currently contained in the semi-monthly
- payments); and
- 17 (2) Retiree life insurance subsidy (to continue existing programs
- currently contained in the semi-monthly payments)."
- Section 3. Severability. If any of the provisions of this Act or the application
- 20 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
- any other provision or application of this Act which can be given effect without the
- 22 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
- 23 severable.
