AN ACT TO ADD A NEW §3117 TO CHAPTER 1 OF 16GCA/RELATIVE TO DRIVERS LICENSES ISSUED TO INDIVIDUALS WITH HEARING AND SPEECH DISABILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. A new Section 3117 is *added* to Chapter 1 of 16GCA to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 §3117. Hearing/speech impaired, driver's license special notation, definitions.
- 5 (a) As used in this section, the following terms mean:
- 6 (1) "Deaf person", any person who, because of hearing loss, is not able to
- discriminate speech when spoken in a normal conversation tone regardless
- 8 of the use of amplification devices;
- 9 (2) "Hearing-impaired person", any person who, because of hearing loss,
- has a diminished capacity to discriminate speech when spoken in a normal
- 11 conversational tone;
- 12 (3) "Speech-impaired person", any person who, because of hearing loss or
- physical or emotional disability, has a diminished capacity to speak;

- 1 (4) HSD, a notation on a driver's license meaning "hearing or speech disability" that indicates the person is a deaf, hearing-impaired or speechimpaired person who uses alternative communication.
- 4 (b). Any resident of Guam who is a deaf, hearing-impaired or speech-impaired person *may* apply to the Department of Revenue and Taxation to have the notation "HSD" placed on the person's driver's license. The Department of Revenue and Taxation shall establish the criteria for placement of the "HSD" notation, such as requiring an applicant to submit certain medical proof of deafness, hearing or speech impairment. This service shall be provided at no additional costs the licensee.
