WHEREAS, Bookmobiles are modern, changing and dynamic mobile information centers for the 21st century, providing not just books, but also DVDs, music, resources for job searches, and more; and

WHEREAS, as an extension of libraries, Bookmobiles are part of the American Dream – places for opportunity, education, self-help and lifelong learning, and Bookmobile use is increasing nationwide among all types of library users; and as such, libraries, librarians, library workers and supporters across America are celebrating "National Bookmobile Day" during National Library Week on April 14, 2010; and

WHEREAS, in 1953, Guam's Bookmobile service began reaching the remote villages using a panel truck, and the old Bookmobile continued as best it could, but was hampered by age and the unavailability of parts on island;

- 2 serving the community, but was later grounded for several years due to a lack
- 3 of funding and personnel; and
- 4 WHEREAS, in 2004, the Guam Public Library System (GPLS)
- 5 Bookmobile was refurbished through the efforts of the First Lady of Guam
- 6 Joann G. Camacho, public-private partnerships, and the generous donated
- 7 resources from Matson Navigation Company and Alexander and Baldwin.
- 8 The Bookmobile was repaired and is being operated at no cost to the
- 9 taxpayers of Guam, and South Pacific Petroleum Corporation (76/Circle K)
- donated the fuel to run the Bookmobile; and
- 11 WHEREAS, to date, the Guam Public Library System Bookmobile,
- 12 "Library on Wheels!", remains operational on Guam's roads serving our
- 13 community as part of its outreach program in its continued efforts to
- 14 promoting literacy in our community; and
- 15 WHEREAS, also, to date, the Guam Public Library System, the
- 16 Bookmobile Foundation of Guam, the First Lady of Guam Joann G. Camacho,
- 17 Matson Navigation Company, and South Pacific Petroleum Corporation
- 18 (76/Circle K), has generously continued its commitment to serving the people
- of Guam by keeping the GPLS Bookmobile operational; now, therefore, be it
