3 **WHEREAS**, in August 1985, Esther Leon Guerrero Keone began her
4 career with the Guam Department of Education, and she was assigned to her
5 first teaching position as a 5th Grade Teacher at *Yigo* Elementary School (which
6 has since been renamed Daniel L. Perez Elementary School); and

7 **WHEREAS**, after teaching at *Yigo* Elementary School for seven (7) years,
8 Esther Leon Guerrero Keone was then transferred to Harmon Loop
9 Elementary School (which has since been renamed J. M. Guerrero Elementary
10 School); she then taught at Chief Brodie Elementary School; and then
11 transferred to Maria A. Ulloa Elementary School; and

12 **WHEREAS**, after her eighteen (18) years of teaching and classroom
13 instruction, Esther Leon Guerrero Keone, in 2003, was assigned to be a School
14 Program Consultant, a position she held for seven (7) years; and

15 **WHEREAS**, as a School Program Consultant, Esther was charged with
16 the responsibility of developing the Summer School Standard Operating
17 Procedures. In addition, Esther was instrumental in the compilation of the
18 District Action Plan, and she served as Co-Chairperson of the Standards and
19 Assessment Committee. Always wanting to better the education system,
20 Esther helped to conduct the Math Alignment for the elementary school level.
21 She also conducted the training for substitute teachers on Lesson Planning

1 and Classroom Management. Esther also wrote the plans, and carried out the
2 activities of the Summer School Program; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Esther helped to complete the *Eskuelan Puengi* Program
4 grant, while at the same time assisted in the compilation of data for the school
5 report cards, and coordinated the orientation for new teachers, and helped to
6 facilitate the development of the Language Arts, Reading, Math (LARM)
7 alignment and curriculum guideline. Esther was also instrumental in the
8 continual update of the Board Policies; now, therefore, be it

10 behalf of the people of Guam, commend and congratulate Esther Leon
11 Guerrero Keone on her retirement from the Guam Department of Education;

15 Wishes to her on her future endeavors; and be it further


16 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary
