1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Jay Shedd was born on September 10, 1960. He is the
4 son of Ralph and Joan Shedd, and has a brother, Dan, and a sister, Ronna
5 Anderson; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Jay is a 1978 graduate of Pacifica High School in Garden
7 Grove, California. In 1983, he attended California State University Long
8 Beach, majoring in Chemistry. In 2007, he received his Liberal Studies Degree
9 while attending Arizona State University. He then furthered his education,
10 attending Network Operations Management School at Motorola University in
11 Shawburg, Illinois; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Jay is married to Sheila Cecile Baker, and they are blessed
13 with two (2) sons, Hayden Daniel (8) and Shane Austin (4); and two (2)
14 daughters, Erica Beatrice (17) and Aiyana Camille (13); and

15 **WHEREAS**, Jay and Sheila are doubly blessed with the newest addition
16 of their grandson, Wyatt, who was born on September 19, 2010; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Shedd was employed with Motorola Communications
18 and Electronics as a Radio Communications Representative, from 1983 to
19 1985; and as the Zone Sales Manager in San Diego, California, from 1985 to
20 1989. He then rose through the ranks of Motorola Communications and
21 Electronics, working as the Regional Sales Manager in Glen Rock, New Jersey,

1 and in Los Angeles, California, from 1989 to 1991. From 1991 to 1993, he was
2 the Territory Business Manager, and then was the Digital Dispatch Sales
3 Manager, from 1993 to 1994, in Irvine, California; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Jay Shedd's career brought him to Guam, to work as
5 the Senior Vice President/General Manager/Corporate Officer of GuamCell
6 Communications, Inc., from 1994 to 2003; and then served as a Consultant for
7 the company. He also performed duties and was the Chief Operating Officer
8 and Partner for RevoTech, LLC, in Tempe, Arizona, from 2001 to 2007, and he
9 provided consultant work for Alternet Systems, Inc., in Washington, from
10 2004 to 2005. Jay's current position is President and Chief Executive Officer of
11 DOCOMO PACIFIC, which was effectuated in May 2008; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Shedd is the recipient of the Governor's "*Ancient*
13 *Order of Chamorri*" for his outstanding achievements in business; and in 2003,
14 he received a Legislative Resolution for transforming the face of
15 telecommunications in Guam. He is a member of several organizations,
16 including: the CDMA Development Group Asia-Pacific; the Andersen Air
17 Force Base Civilian Advisory Council; the Board of the American Red Cross,
18 Guam Chapter; the Board of Directors of the A.B. Won Pat International
19 Airport Authority; the Board of the Governor's Council for Y2K; and the
20 Governor's Vision 2001 Task Force for Telecommunications. Jay also served
21 as the 1998 Chairman of the American Cancer Society's "Relay for Life"; and
22 as the Co-Chairman of the GuamCell Communications, Inc./Sorensen Pacific

1 Broadcasting Annual Golf Tournament in 2000, 2001, and 2002, which
2 benefited the American Red Cross, the Boy Scouts of America, and the Girl
3 Scouts of America charities; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Jay was nominated and accepted into the “Who’s Who for
5 International Executives”. In 1999, he was nominated as a Board Member for
6 the Guam Chamber of Commerce, and was also nominated by Guam Business
7 News Magazine as the “Guam Business Person of the Year”, from 2000 to
8 2002; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Shedd continues his active involvement in the Guam
10 Chapter of the American Red Cross; the Rotary Club of Guam; the Guam
11 Chamber of Commerce Armed Forces Committee; and the Andersen Air
12 Force Advisory Committee; and

13 **WHEREAS**, in his personal and professional life, Jay assiduously
14 stresses integrity and respect for others, and he has served as a source of
15 inspiration to his colleagues, friends, and family, and to whom he always
16 encourages spiritual, personal, and professional growth; now, therefore, be it
