6 WHEREAS, Jay is a 1978 graduate of Pacifica High School in Garden 7 Grove, California. In 1983, he attended California State University Long 8 Beach, majoring in Chemistry. In 2007, he received his Liberal Studies Degree 9 while attending Arizona State University. He then furthered his education, 10 attending Network Operations Management School at Motorola University in 11 Shawburg, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, Jay is married to Sheila Cecile Baker, and they are blessed
with two (2) sons, Hayden Daniel (8) and Shane Austin (4); and two (2)
daughters, Erica Beatrice (17) and Aiyana Camille (13); and

WHEREAS, Jay and Sheila are doubly blessed with the newest addition
of their grandson, Wyatt, who was born on September 19, 2010; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Shedd was employed with Motorola Communications and Electronics as a Radio Communications Representative, from 1983 to 1985; and as the Zone Sales Manager in San Diego, California, from 1985 to 201989. He then rose through the ranks of Motorola Communications and Electronics, working as the Regional Sales Manager in Glen Rock, New Jersey, and in Los Angeles, California, from 1989 to 1991. From 1991 to 1993, he was
 the Territory Business Manager, and then was the Digital Dispatch Sales
 Manager, from 1993 to 1994, in Irvine, California; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Jay Shedd's career brought him to Guam, to work as 4 the Senior Vice President/General Manager/Corporate Officer of GuamCell 5 Communications, Inc., from 1994 to 2003; and then served as a Consultant for 6 the company. He also performed duties and was the Chief Operating Officer 7 8 and Partner for RevoTech, LLC, in Tempe, Arizona, from 2001 to 2007, and he 9 provided consultant work for Alternet Systems, Inc., in Washington, from 2004 to 2005. Jay's current position is President and Chief Executive Officer of 10 DOCOMO PACIFIC, which was effectuated in May 2008; and 11

12 WHERREAS, Mr. Shedd is the recipient of the Governor's "Ancient Order of Chamorri" for his outstanding achievements in business; and in 2003, 13 he received a Legislative Resolution for transforming the face of 14 telecommunications in Guam. He is a member of several organizations, 15 including: the CDMA Development Group Asia-Pacific; the Andersen Air 16 Force Base Civilian Advisory Council; the Board of the American Red Cross, 17 18 Guam Chapter; the Board of Directors of the A.B. Won Pat International Airport Authority; the Board of the Governor's Council for Y2K; and the 19 Governor's Vision 2001 Task Force for Telecommunications. Jay also served 20 as the 1998 Chairman of the American Cancer Society's "Relay for Life"; and 21 as the Co-Chairman of the GuamCell Communications, Inc./Sorensen Pacific 22

Broadcasting Annual Golf Tournament in 2000, 2001, and 2002, which
 benefited the American Red Cross, the Boy Scouts of America, and the Girl
 Scouts of America charities; and

WHEREAS, Jay was nominated and accepted into the "Who's Who for
International Executives". In 1999, he was nominated as a Board Member for
the Guam Chamber of Commerce, and was also nominated by Guam Business
News Magazine as the "Guam Business Person of the Year", from 2000 to
2002; and
