1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**

3 **WHEREAS**, Master Sergeant Morris A. Miller is the devoted husband
4 of Cynthia Miller, and the proud father of three (3) children: Amanda, 16;
5 Alexandra, 14; and Alannah, 11; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Miller is a First Sergeant of the 36th
7 Communications Squadron, Andersen Air Force Base, Guam; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Miller is the principal advisor to the
9 Commander on all enlisted personnel, and his responsibilities include
10 keeping the Commander apprised of matters affecting the utilization,
11 health, morale and welfare of all enlisted members assigned; and

12 **WHEREAS**, in 1986, Sergeant Miller embarked on his military career,
13 enlisting in the U.S. Air Force; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Miller graduated from the Aircraft Armament
15 Systems Specialist Course at Lowry Technical Training School, and was
16 an Honor Graduate; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Miller's first assignment was at Davis-Monthan
18 Air Force Base in Tucson, Arizona, where he maintained the weapon
19 systems on the OA-37 aircraft for six (6) months, and he then transferred to
20 the A-10 Thunderbolt II; and

1 **WHEREAS**, in 1991, Sergeant Miller left Davis-Monthan Air Force
2 Base, and was transferred to Osan AB, Republic of Korea, to work as a
3 Controller in the Maintenance Operations Center; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Miller returned to Davis-Monthan Air Force
5 Base in 1992, where he maintained and loaded A-10s; and

6 **WHEREAS**, in 1997, Sergeant Miller was stationed at Aviano AB,
7 Italy, where he maintained the F-16 Fighting Falcon, and he was directly
8 involved in the Allied Force; and

9 **WHEREAS**, after a three (3) year tour, Sergeant Miller returned to the
10 United States, and was stationed at Cannon A.F.B., Clovis, New Mexico;
11 and

12 **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Miller was then assigned once again to Osan
13 AB, Republic of Korea, where he was the Weapons Academic Instructor;
14 and

15 **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Miller's follow-on from Osan was at the RAF
16 Lakenheath, England, where he was a maintainer/loader on the F-15E
17 Strike Eagle, and he later served as the Acting First Sergeant for the 48th
18 AMXS; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Miller graduated from the United States Air
20 Force First Sergeant Academy in March 2007; and

1 **WHEREAS**, throughout his professional career, Sergeant Miller has
2 accumulated many awards and decorations, to include: the Meritorious
3 Service Medal; the Air Force Commendation Medal with two (2) oak leaf
4 clusters; the Air Force Achievement Medal with three (3) oak leaf clusters;
5 the Air Force Outstanding Unit Award with silver oak leaf cluster; the Air
6 Force Good Conduct Medal with silver oak leaf cluster; the National
7 Defense Service Medal with bronze star; the Kosovo Campaign Medal
8 with bronze star; the Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal; the
9 Global War on Terrorism Service Medal; the Korean Defense Service
10 Medal; and the NATO medal; now, therefore, be it

12 *LiheSlaturan Guâhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I LiheSlaturan Guâhan* and
13 the people of Guam, recognize and congratulate Master Sergeant Morris A.


