1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA’BENTE NUEBI NA LIHESLATURAN**
2 **GUÅHAN ON BEHALF OF THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

3 **WHEREAS**, since arriving on Guam on 2004, Madhusudhan “Madhu”
4 Seshadri served as Vice-President/Cards Business and Marketing Head, and since
5 2006, as Vice President and Country Corporate Officer / Business Manager for
6 Citibank Guam and served the critical role of safeguarding and championing the
7 Citigroup franchise; and

8 **WHEREAS**, under Madhusudhan “Madhu” Seshadri’s leadership and client-
9 first philosophy, Citibank Guam expanded its distribution channels for the
10 convenience of their customers, invested in technological enhancements, launched
11 innovative products and services, enhanced customer service, established new
12 client relationships, and contributed towards community development through
13 employee volunteer efforts and philanthropic giving; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Madhusudhan “Madhu” Seshadri worked to make Citibank
15 Guam the leading lender of consumer loans, increased the distribution channel of
16 Quick Pay locations by 3 through Shell Stations, added 7 ATM locations in central
17 and northern Guam, doubled the number of full-service ATM’s from 5 to 11,

1 launched the Citibank Guam Platinum card and added 2 frequent flyer programs
2 into Citi's Rewards Card Redemption program – Continental Airlines' One Pass
3 Miles Program and Philippine Airlines' Mabuhay Miles Program; and

5 institution that by fourth quarter 2009 will offer their customers a larger array of
6 products and services to choose from that will assist them in achieving their
7 financial goals with greater efficiency; and

9 Citibank Guam business, the Citi Foundation gave \$300,000 in grants, of which
10 \$200,000 went towards general education programs and more than \$100,000 to
11 Financial Education and Community Development initiatives. Recipients and
12 beneficiaries of grant funds include Marcial A. Sablan Elementary School, Inarajan
13 Elementary School, George Washington High School, St. John's School, Big
14 Brothers Big Sisters of Guam, The Salvation Army Guam Chapter, Junior
15 Achievement Guam, Habitat For Humanity Guam, Guam Community College,
16 University of Guam TRIO Program and GCA Trades Academy; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Madhusudhan "Madhu" Seshadri guided and supported the
18 Citi Guam's employees' passion to serve the island community through the Citi
19 Global Community Day - an annual event when employees, along with their
20 families and friends, come together as a global team to share their time, talents and
21 resources on projects in their respective locale. Citi Guam's Global Community
22 Day events encompassed projects which have positively impacted our
23 environment, our youth and senior citizens, the homeless, and people in need.
24 Projects and beneficiaries were Holiday meals for Guam Memorial Hospital's
25 Skilled Nursing Unit patients and their families and the residents of Guma
26 Trankilidat, the Food Drive for The Salvation Army, Sanctuary's Inc.'s 5K

1 Run/Walk, Habitat for Humanity of Guam Rummage Sale, the Clean up at the War
2 in the Pacific Asan Beach Park and feeding the needy at Kusinan Karidat.; and

3 **WHEREAS,** Madhusudhan “Madhu” Seshadri set the example of
4 community service through his active involvement in the Guam Chamber of
5 Commerce, the Sunrise Rotary Club of Guam, and the Junior Achievement Guam
6 Chapter; and

7 **WHEREAS,** Madhusudhan “Madhu” Seshadri, with his wife Nandini,
8 daughter Aparajita and son Annirudh, will relocate to Singapore as the Regional
9 Cards Director for Citibank; now therefore be it

11 hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam commend and congratulate Madhusudhan
12 “Madhu” Seshadri on his successful term on Guam; and be it further
