Relative to recognizing Guam's Certified Government Financial Managers (CGFM) of the Association of Government Accountants Guam Chapter in honor of CGFM Month March 2010.

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA'TRENTA  
2 NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

3 WHEREAS, the Association of Government Accountants (AGA) is a  
4 professional organization with a network of fifteen thousand (15,000) members in over  
5 one hundred (100) chapters across the United States and around the world representing  
6 state, federal, local and private sector government accountability professionals; and

7 WHEREAS, the AGA Guam Chapter has one hundred sixty-five (165) members  
8 who work to uphold AGA's mission of Advancing Government Accountability, as it  
9 continues its broad educational efforts, with emphasis on high standards of conduct,  
10 honor and character in its *Code of Ethics*, and are making significant advances both in  
11 professional ability and in service to the citizens of Guam by mastering increasingly  
12 technical and complex requirements, and

13 WHEREAS, the Certified Government Financial Manager (CGFM) Program of  
14 AGA provides a means of demonstrating professionalism and competency by requiring  
15 CGFM candidates, twenty-four (24) of which are from the AGA Guam Chapter, to have  
16 appropriate education and professional experience, to abide by AGA's *Code of Ethics*  
17 and to pass three examinations requiring expertise in Governmental Environment,

1 Governmental Financial Management and Control, and Governmental Accounting,  
2 Financial Reporting and Budgeting, and requires each CGFM to maintain certification  
3 by completing at least 80 hours of continuing professional education in government  
4 financial management topics or related technical subjects every two years; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the AGA CGFM Guam team is led by Doreen T. Crisostomo, Ph.D  
6 who is the CGFM Director for the AGA-Guam Chapter and the overall CGFM  
7 Coordinator for the AGA-Pacific Rim; the AGA-Guam Chapter is lead by President Jojo  
8 Guevara III, CGFM and Vice President of the AGA-Pacific Rim, AGA-Guam Chapter,  
9 Zeny Asuncion-Nace, CGFM, CPA, CFE; and

10 **WHEREAS**, these dedicated individuals lead a passionate group of people in the  
11 government financial management profession, which is characterized by its efforts to  
12 achieve common objectives and by its observance of certain fundamental principles;  
13 these AGA CGFM members must adhere to ethical requirements to ensure the highest  
14 quality of performance and to maintain public confidence in the profession; now,  
15 therefore, be it

16 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules, on behalf of *I Mina' Trenta Na*  
17 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam, does hereby recognize Guam's Certified  
18 Government Financial Managers (CGFM) of the Association of Government  
19 Accountants Guam Chapter in honor of CGFM Month March 2010; and be it further
