



Patton Elementary School in Fort Ord, California, from kindergarten through the sixth (6th) grade; he attended *Barrigada* Junior High School (now Untalan Middle School) from the seventh (7th) grade through the ninth (9th) grade; and, he attended John F. Kennedy High School where he graduated in 1978; and
- WHEREAS**, from 1981 to 1989, Mr. Cepeda worked as an On-Call Substitute Teacher and School Aide for several elementary, middle, and high schools; and
- WHEREAS**, during his tenure serving as an On-Call Substitute Teacher, his passion for educating our island's school students became stronger, which led him to attend the University of Guam, where he majored in Elementary Education and graduated in 1989 with a Bachelor's Degree; and




