- BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I
 MINA'TRENTAI KUÅTTRO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:
 WHEREAS, I Mina'Trentai Kuåttro Na Liheslaturan Guåhan Otden
- *Areklamento* (the Thirty-Fourth Guam Legislature Standing Rules) establishes the rules
 and procedures of *I Mina 'Trentai Kuåttro Na Liheslaturan Guåhan*; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the Standing Rules were duly adopted by lawmakers on January 2,
 7 2017; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* was formally notified of a 9 permanent vacancy existing in the Chairmanship of the Committee on Rules on June 10 30, 2017; and
- WHEREAS, Section 2.09(a) of the Standing Rules of the 34th Guam Legislature states in relevant part: "If a permanent vacancy occurs in the position of Chairperson of a Standing Committee, the Speaker shall reorganize, eliminate or reassign to other

Standing Committees the duties, functions and budget of the Committee in question, at
 the Speaker's option with the majority vote of the Committee on Rules"; and now
 therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Kuåttro Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* hereby *amends* the Standing Rules- Part A, Rule I, Section 1.01

The Committee on 6 Rules shall have jurisdiction over the Guam Congress Building and the Speaker 7 Antonio R. Unpingco Legislative Session Hall, including, but not limited to, 8 9 procedures for ensuring security of the building and the Hall and oversight of the admission of visitors in the visitor areas, both during and outside Session meeting 10 11 times: (1) Legislative Printing. The Chairperson of the Committee on Rules 12 shall order copies of laws, journals, file forms and other materials necessary. 13 (m) Legislative Lobbyists. The Committee on Rules shall have the 14 15 authority to monitor to ensure compliance with or to receive and dispose of any complaints alleging any violations of §8101 of Chapter 8 of Title 2 of the Guam 16 Code Annotated, relative to the registration and regulation of legislative 17 18 lobbyists."; and be it further RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of I Mina'Trentai Kuåttro Na 19 Liheslaturan Guåhan hereby adds the Standing Rules- Part C, Rule XI, Section 11.11: 20 "Section 11.11. Powers, Authority and Composition of the 21 **Committee on Legislative Operations.** 22 Membership. The Committee on Legislative Operations shall (a) 23 consist of the following voting Members: 24 the Chairperson, selected by the Speaker under Rule 2.09(a); 25 (1)the Speaker; 26 (2)

- 1 (3)all Chairpersons of the other Standing Committees; and two (2) members of the Minority as the Chairperson selects. 2 (4) Authority of Chairperson; Votes Required to Act. 3 (b) The Chairperson of the Committee on Legislative Operations shall act on behalf of 4 the Committee in all matters prescribed herein. Any and all action taken by the 5 Committee on Legislative Operations requiring a vote pursuant to these Rules 6 7 shall be effective upon an affirmative vote by six (6) Members of the Committee 8 on Legislative Operations. (c) Policy-Making Body. The Committee on Legislative Operations is 9 constituted as the policy-making Body of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. 10 The 11 Committee *shall* prescribe all policies governing the administration and operation of the Central Office of I Liheslaturan Guåhan, including staff organization. 12 functions, personnel requirements and rates of compensation. 13 (d) Inventory of Property. The Chairperson of the Committee on 14 15 Legislative Operations is authorized and directed to make and maintain a complete inventory of all property of I Liheslaturan Guåhan, including all 16 property in the possession or control of any Committee. The Committee on 17 Legislative Operations *shall* have custody and control of all such property of I 18 Liheslaturan Guåhan, and the Committee on Legislative Operations shall adopt 19 20 such rules or orders as it may determine are necessary relating to the purchase, 21 care, custody, use or disposal thereof. Budget.  5 shall have the authority to monitor to ensure compliance with or to receive and
 6 dispose of any complaints alleging any violations of §8101 of Chapter 8 of Title
 7 2 of the Guam Code Annotated, relative to the registration and regulation of
 8 legislative lobbyists."; and be it further
- 9 RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Kuåttro Na*10 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* hereby *amends* the Standing Rules- Part D, Rule XIII to read:
- 11 "Except for Attachés elected by the Members, no person may occupy any position within the Central Legislative Staff unless such position has first been 12 13 approved by the Chairperson of the Committee on Legislative Operations Rules, 14 or is approved in the budget to be adopted pursuant to Rule XIV, such approval 15 to include as to each position title, salary or compensation, job description, and 16 an indication as to whether the position is full time or part time. The selection of individuals to occupy such approved Central Legislative slots shall be made by 17 the Chairperson of the Committee on Legislative Operations Rules. 18
- The Chairperson of the 19 Section 13.01. **Executive Director.** Committee on Legislative Operations Rules may hire an Executive Director 20 (Director), who shall be under the supervision of the Chairperson of the 21 22 Committee on Legislative Operations Rules, who may discipline and dismiss the 23 Executive Director, and may be immediately responsible for the day-to-day operations and administration of I Liheslaturan Guåhan. The Director and the 24 Deputy Director, if any, shall be appointed by the Chairperson and shall 25 implement and enforce policies and regulations established and appropriated to 26

1 that person's duties, and *shall* perform such other duties as are assigned to that 2 person by the Chairperson. The Director may recommend policy changes and 3 new procedures to the Chairperson of the Committee on Legislative Operations Rules. Legislative staff personnel, not employed by the Legislative Officers, the 4 Standing Committees, or an individual Senator, and who are working for the 5 Central Staff shall come under the supervision of the Director. The Director is 6 designated the Disbursing Officer of I Mina'Trentai Kuåttro Na Liheslaturan 7 Guåhan. 8

9 The Director *shall* be responsible for personnel processing, travel processing, property control, procurement of supplies and maintenance of all 10 records of legislative expenses, including staff salaries, wages and working 11 hours. In the absence of the Director, the Deputy Director, if any, shall perform 12 13 the functions of the Director in an acting capacity. In the absence of the Director 14 and the Deputy Director, if any, the Chairperson of the Committee on Legislative Operations Rules shall appoint an Acting Director to act in such capacity and 15 16 perform the functions of the Director.

Supervision by Executive Director. The Central Legislative 17 (a) 18 Staff shall be under the direction of the Executive Director, and the Chairperson of the Committee on Legislative Operations Rules, and shall 19 20 have such duties and carry out such responsibilities as shall be assigned to 21 them from time to time. In performing any such duties, all employees of I22 Liheslaturan Guåhan shall maintain inviolate the confidences of each Senator and *shall* disclose or publish the same *only* when specifically 23 authorized to do so. 24

25 Section 13.02. The Chief Fiscal Officer. The Chief Fiscal Officer *shall* 26 be under the supervision of the Chairperson of the Committee on Legislative

Operations Rules, who shall have among that person's powers the authority to 1 discipline and dismiss the Chief Fiscal Officer, and shall be immediately 2 responsible for fiscal matters pertaining to I Liheslaturan Guåhan. The Chief 3 Fiscal Officer and a Deputy Chief Fiscal Officer, if any, *shall* be appointed by 4 the Chairperson of the Committee on Legislative Operations Rules. The Chief 5 Fiscal Officer shall serve as the Certifying Officer of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and 6 of I Liheslaturan Guåhan's Operations Fund, and shall have overall 7 responsibility for budgetary and accounting functions, subject to the direction and 8 supervision of the Chairperson of the Committee on Legislative Operations 9 Rules, and shall perform such other duties as are assigned to the Chief Fiscal 10 11 Officer by the Chairperson of the Committee on Legislative Operations Rules.

12 The Chief Fiscal Officer *shall* make a monthly report to the Members as 13 to expenditures under the Legislative Operation Budget. In the absence of the 14 Chief Fiscal Officer, the Deputy Chief Fiscal Officer *shall* perform the functions 15 of the Chief Fiscal Officer in an acting capacity. In the absence of the Chief 16 Fiscal Officer and the Deputy, the Chairperson of the Committee on <u>Legislative</u> 17 <u>Operations Rules *shall* appoint an Acting Chief Fiscal Officer to perform the 18 functions of the Chief Fiscal Officer.</u>

19Section 13.03. Discharge of Employees. The Executive Director, with20the concurrence of the Chairperson of the Committee on Legislative Operations21Rules, may suspend or discharge, or otherwise discipline, employees of the22Central Staff of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* without cause. Other employees may be23suspended or discharged by the Senator, Officer, Committee Chairperson or24Minority Office from whose budget they are paid without cause.

Section 13.04. The Chief Protocol Officer. The Chief Protocol Officer
 shall be under the supervision of the Chairperson of the Committee on Legislative

1 Operations Rules, who shall have among that person's powers the authority to discipline and dismiss the Chief Protocol Officer, and shall be immediately 2 3 responsible for protocol matters pertaining to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. The Chief 4 Protocol Officer shall be appointed by the Chairperson of the Committee on 5 Legislative Operations Rules. The Chief Protocol Officer shall coordinate official 6 visits of the legislature by dignitaries and other persons, direct the conduct of 7 state functions, to include official addresses, provide support staffing for public hearings, oversee the operations of audio and visual recording and production, 8 maintain legislative facilities and grounds, act as historian of the legislature, and 9 shall have overall responsibility for the protocol office functions, subject to the 10 direction and supervision of the Chairperson of the Committee Legislative 11 Operations Rules, and shall perform such other duties as are assigned to the Chief 12 Protocol Officer by the Chairperson of the Committee on Legislative Operations 13 Rules. 14

15In the absence of the Chief Protocol Officer, the Chairperson of the16Committee on Legislative Operations Rules shall appoint and Acting Chief17Protocol Officer to perform the functions of the Chief Protocol Officer.

Section 13.05. Speech and Debate Clause Privilege Asserted. Unless
 otherwise expressly provided to the contrary, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* hereby
 asserts its Speech and Debate Clause privileges on behalf of itself, its committees,
 and its staffers pursuant to Title 48 United States Code §1423c(b), Privileges of
 Members."; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Kuåttro Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* hereby amends the Standing Rules- Part E, Rule XIV, Section
 14.02 to read:

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"Section 14.02. General Rules. The following general rules *shall* apply to legislative personnel:

(a) Personnel Elected by I Liheslaturan Guåhan. The
Legislative Counsel, the Clerk of the Legislature, the Sergeant-at-Arms,
and the Chaplain shall be elected by the Members of I Liheslaturan *Guåhan* as prescribed by law. The Legislative Secretary shall certify the
results of such elections to the Chairperson of the Committee on
Legislative Operations Rules.

9 Employee of a Senator, Legislative Office or a Standing **(b) Committee.** An employee of a Senator, of a Legislative Officer, or of a 10 Standing Committee *shall* be selected by the Senator, by the Officer or by 11 the Chairperson of the Standing Committee, which selection shall be 12 evidenced by a memorandum to the Chairperson of the Committee on 13 Legislative Operations Rules from the Senator, Officer or Chairperson. 14 The signature of the Chairperson of the Committee shall be required for 15 16 all hiring actions by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*.

All Other Employees. All other employees of *I Liheslaturan* 17 (c) Guåhan shall be selected by the Executive Director, except for the 18 Executive Director in a manner prescribed by the Committee on Rules, the 19 20 Deputy Executive Director, the Chief Fiscal Officer and the Deputy Chief Fiscal Officer, whose methods of selection are elsewhere detailed, with the 21 concurrence of the Chairperson of the Committee on Legislative 22 23 Operations Rules for positions which have been authorized by the Committee on Legislative Operations Rules. Selection of an employee 24 shall be evidenced by a memorandum from the Chairperson of the 25 Committee on Rules to the Committee on Legislative Operations Rules. 26

Selection, Appointment and Dismissal of Employees. 1 (d) 2 Unless otherwise specified by law or prescribed by the Chairperson of the 3 Committee on Legislative Operations, the selection, appointment and 4 dismissal of a full-time or part-time employee, not employed by the Officers, Standing Committees or the Minority shall be either by the 5 Executive Director, with the concurrence of the Chairperson of the 6 7 Committee on Legislative Operations Rules, or by the Chairperson of the Committee on Legislative Operations Rules; provided, that such selection, 8 9 appointment or dismissal may be nullified by majority vote of the Committee on Legislative Operations."; and be it further 10

RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Kuåttro Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* hereby *amends* the Standing Rules- Part E, Rule XIV, Section
 14.03 to read:

14 "Section 14.03. Administration. These Rules *shall* control the
15 administration of personnel matters in *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. Subject to these
16 Rules and such other administrative regulations as are promulgated, the

Outstanding advances which have not been fully recovered by deductions from reimbursement vouchers or voluntary 22 refunds by the traveler may be recovered promptly by the Executive Director, 23 upon the approval of the Chairperson of the Committee on Legislative Operations 24 Rules, by set off of salary due, or by such other legal method of recovery as may 25 be necessary; provided, that no such set-off of salary shall be undertaken until ten 26

(10) days after the return to Guam of the traveler. No traveler shall be reimbursed
 for travel costs *not* actually incurred by the traveler."; and be it further

10 Leave as a Result of Illness or Injury. Whenever a (a) Member, Attaché or an employee on official travel takes leave of absence 11 due to illness or injury not caused by the individual's own misconduct, 12 13 the prescribed per diem shall be continued not to exceed seven (7) days in 14 any one (1) period of absence, *unless*, contingent upon the circumstances 15 in a particular case, a longer period is approved by the Chairperson of the 16 Committee on Legislative Operations Rules. Evidence of the illness or injury may be required to be submitted with the travel voucher. The type 17 18 of leave and duration thereof must be shown on the voucher.
