1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI KUATRO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, on March 14, 1959 Evangeline Fallejo-Ramos Allen was born to
4 proud parents Vicente Manangan Ramos and Leonila Fallejo Ramos; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Evangeline Fallejo-Ramos Allen moved to Guam with her family
6 at the age of 6. She graduated from George Washington Senior High School and is
7 1982 graduate of the University of Guam with a Bachelor of Arts in Psychology. She
8 then obtained a Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing through the Medical Enlisted
9 Commissioning Program from Hampton University in 1992. She holds a Master's of
10 Science Degree in Nursing from Rush University, and a Master's Degree in
11 Education from Northern Illinois University; and

12 **WHEREAS**, in August 1994 she reported to Naval Hospital Great Lakes,
13 where she acquired the leadership and managerial skills as a charge nurse in the

1 Intensive Care Unit and Medical-Surgical Ward. She transferred to the Recruit
2 Training Command in Great Lakes, Illinois, where she functioned as the Division
3 Officer for the Acute Care Treatment Room and Clinic Nurse for the Women's
4 Health Clinic. She was promoted to Lieutenant in May 1996; and

5 **WHEREAS;** in October 1997, Lieutenant Allen reported to Naval Hospital
6 Corps School in Great Lakes, where she instructed a total of 750 students until August
7 2001. She actively pursued and completed a Master's Degree in Education from
8 Northern Illinois University in May 2001 and was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant
9 Commander. She was selected for Duty Under Instruction and attended Rush
10 University in Chicago, Illinois, where she obtained a Master of Science in Nursing as
11 a Maternal-Child Clinical Nurse Specialist in May 2003. She then reported to Naval
12 Medical Center San Diego (NMCSD), where she assumed dual roles as a Perinatal
13 Clinical Nurse Specialist and as a Division Officer for the Labor and Delivery Unit
14 which averaged 4,200 births per year; and

15 **WHEREAS,** Lieutenant Commander Allen reported to U.S. Naval Hospital
16 Yokosuka, Japan in September 2005 to fill a critical billet and assumed dual roles as
17 Department Head and Clinical Nurse Specialist of the Maternal-Infant Unit until
18 September 2007. She then transferred to Naval Hospital Bremerton and was the
19 Division Officer for the Pediatric Clinic and Family Medicine Department. She was
20 promoted to the rank of Commander May 2008. She then reported to U.S. Naval
21 Hospital Guam and functioned as the Clinical Nurse Specialist for the Mother-Baby
22 Unit and a year later, assumed the role as Assistant Director for Nursing Services and
23 Department Head of the Inpatient Units. She was one of three advanced practice
24 nurses who founded and chartered the Guam Association of Advanced Practice
25 Registered Nurses (GAAPRN) in October 2010. She was also an adjunct faculty at the
26 University Of Guam School Of Nursing. She was the clinical instructor for ten senior

1 nursing students during their clinical rotation at Guam Memorial Hospital's Labor and
2 Delivery and Newborn Nursery Units; and

3 **WHEREAS**, she is currently serving as Department Head of Healthcare
4 Business, overseeing the Case Management, Utilization Management, Referral
5 Management, and Tricare Operations departments while also serving as a Nurse Case
6 Manager. She serves as the command's Point of Contact for Transgender Care and
7 provides case management support to the Limited Duty Program's multidisciplinary
8 team. She was selected as the Senior Nurse for the Medical Planning Team, 2017
9 Pacific Partnership Malaysia Engagement and as the Senior Nurse for the Vietnam
10 Engagement, where she taught leadership and managerial topics to 150 nurse leaders
11 from DaNang hospitals; and

12 **WHEREAS**, she is blessed with the love of her children: Derrick Emory Allen
13 and Neka Pearl Allen and together reside in the village of *Mangilao*; and

14 **WHEREAS**, her plans after retirement is to continue with her volunteerism
15 efforts and take care of her mother who is 93 years old; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Commander Allen's institutional knowledge and dedication will
17 be missed by the many individuals whose lives were touched in her profession; and
18 now be it
