- WHEREAS, the United States Congress in Public Law 915 authorized
- 4 the President of the United States to designate September 17th as Constitution
- 5 Day, and recognized the signing of the Constitution in 1787 as a document that
- 6 "embodies the principles of limited government in a republic dedicated to the
- 7 rule of law"; and
- 8 WHEREAS, in its Preamble, the U.S. Constitution inspires and
- 9 unites its citizens "to form a more perfect Union, establish Justice, insure
- domestic Tranquility, provide for the common defense, promote the general

- Welfare, and secure the Blessings of Liberty to ourselves and our Posterity";

- WHEREAS, the U.S. Constitution has evolved through the
- 4 interpretation of the Supreme Court and through legislative and citizen-led
- 5 amendments, and some of the Amendments to the U.S. Constitution are
- 6 beacons of hope for many Americans, extending the Bill of Rights to most
- 7 Americans, including the Freedom of Religion, Freedom of Speech,
- 8 Freedom of the Press, the Right to Assemble Peacefully, the protection
- 9 against Unreasonable Searches and Seizures, the Right to Due Process of
- Law, the Right to a Speedy and Fair Trial, the Right to Trial by Jury,
- 11 protection against Cruel and Unusual Punishment, and reserving other
- rights for the States; and
- 13 WHEREAS, the Governor of Guam has proclaimed the week of
- September 17th through September 23rd as Constitution Week, and asks
- citizens to reaffirm the ideals that the framers of the Constitution laid out in
