4 government service as a Clerk Typist I at the Department of Labor through August
5 17, 1977; and

6 **WHEREAS,** Anne moved to the Department of Administration Human
7 Resources Division on October 25, 1977 as Clerk Typist I through August 30, 1978;
8 and

9 **WHEREAS,** Anne served the Executive Branch at the Governor's Office as
10 Clerk Typist III on August 28, 1978 through December 1978; and

11 **WHEREAS,** Anne excelled by working hard by increasing her abilities that
12 warranted a promotion to Clerk Typist IV on December 18, 1978; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Anne was then transferred to Department of Public Health &
2 Social Services that December as Clerk Typist IV through July 1, 1980; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Anne, in her strengths of diversity and technical assistance, was
4 promoted on April 2, 1984 to Assistance Payment Worker I and promoted to
5 Assistance Payment Worker II on April 3, 1985; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Anne was promoted on October 1, 1986 as Eligibility Specialist I;
7 and subsequently took additional responsibilities in the capacity as Eligibility
8 Specialist II on October 1, 1991 through November 23, 1994; and

10 April 7, 2014, as she was promoted to Eligibility Specialist Supervisor through her
11 retirement on August 1, 2017; and
