WHEREAS, Guam Cancer Care is a non-profit organization established on June

2, 2011. It is a local organization created for the primary purpose of bridging the gaps

5 of services that our local cancer patients face. Their key objective is to service cancer

patients on island through core programs such as Patient Navigation, Financial

Assistance, and Patient Transport Program. Through the years, they've expanded their

programs to include Cancer Screening, Cancer Education and Community Outreach, in

an effort to raise cancer awareness and prevention efforts here on Guam; and

WHEREAS, The Sixth (6^{th)} Annual Get Your Pink On (GYPO) WAVE kicks off their island's Breast Cancer Awareness Month activities, on October 2, 2017. This event is an opportunity for our island community to not only show support and raise breast cancer awareness, but also to honor the courage and strength of those who have fought and those who continue to fight the battle against breast cancer; and

WHEREAS, the 16th Annual Strides for the Cure 2K/5K Run will be held on October 7, 2017, in an effort to raise breast cancer awareness, get our community physically active and raise funds for our cancer education and physical fitness program, KIDS FOR THE CURE. The program has reached over six thousand four-hundred (6,400) elementary students and aims to reach another nine hundred (900) students

during this school year; and

WHEREAS, as part of their Breast Cancer Awareness events, our screening program launches its annual Get Your Pink On screening campaign, with six (6) of our local mammography providers joining our efforts in getting our female population screened for breast cancer. Through the cancer prevention and screening efforts, over forty thousand (40,000) local residents have been reached; and
