3 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Victoria M.P. Cepeda is a 1978 Graduate of the Academy of
4 Our Lady of Guam. Mrs. Cepeda began her government career in July 1979 with the
5 Department of Education as a Special Education Aide. From July 1987 to August 1989,
6 Mrs. Cepeda was a Clerk II at the Government of Guam Retirement Agency and then
7 advanced to Word Processing Secretary I then to Word Processing Secretary II in
8 February 1997; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Victoria M.P. Cepeda, in February 2003, latterly transferred
10 to the Department of Revenue and Taxation as a Word Processing Secretary II in the
11 Director's Office. In February 2004, she was detailed to the Taxpayer Service
12 Division, Electronic Data Processing Branch and then moved to the U.S. Passport
13 Division in February 2005 to February 2008. Mrs. Cepeda returned to the Taxpayer
14 Service Division, Central Files Branch; where lastly, in February 2010 to present, she
15 was detailed to the Chief of Administration office; and

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1 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Victoria M.P. Cepeda is an active member of the Revenue and
2 Taxation Employees Association (RATEA) and has always been a supporter of all
3 department events and functions. Mrs. Cepeda retires from Government of Guam
4 service on September 29, 2017. She will notably be missed by her colleagues and
5 customers alike at the Department of Revenue and Taxation; and
