WHEREAS, the Port continues to build upon its core competencies and resiliency by improving and expanding its operational efficiencies, maximizing its capacity, enhancing its security and monitoring systems, and consistently providing excellent service to island residents, the private sector, the federal and local governments, and Department of Defense entities; and

WHEREAS, in the midst of undertaking improvements to modernizing its footprint, the Port has completed additional capital improvement projects, to include: the activation and implementation of its Terminal Operating System (TOS); the rehabilitation and upgrade of several docks at its *Hagåtña* and *Agat* Marinas; the installation of an ADA compliant curb ramp at the Administration Building; the Harbor Master Office renovation; Phase II of the Container Yard Lighting Project; the Container Yard Striping; and the design and construction of canopies at the EQMR building, drum lot, and heavy equipment areas; and

WHEREAS, the Port successfully applied for and was granted Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000) from the U.S. Department of Transportation's Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER) Grant Program to rehabilitate and upgrade Hotel Wharf and its upland facilities, and a four thousand two hundred (4,200) feet long access roadway; and


WHEREAS, the Port has further enhanced its maritime and port security posture by acquiring Port Security Grant Program (PSGP) funding for the purchase of additional digital high-powered cameras for its *Hagåtña*, *Agat*, and Port locations; the completion of a cyber-security assessment that resulted in a report outlining recommendations to safeguard the Port's IT and security systems; the maintenance and sustainment of its CCTV and access control systems and its prime power generators; the renovation and upgrade of four (4) load center buildings housing the Port's prime power generators; and the delivery of ICS and NIMS training for Port staff; and

WHEREAS, the Employees, Management, and Board of Directors of the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port Authority continue to remain steadfastly committed to taking on the challenges of modernizing the Port to meet the ever-changing needs of the island's economic growth; now therefore, be it

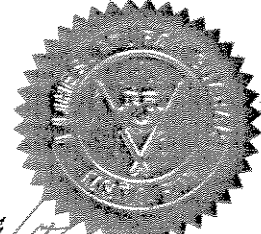
