3 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Hunter Tsui and Mrs. Jean Tsui have made Guam their
4 home since 1972 when they arrived from Taiwan; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Tsui arrived to Guam on assignment by his employer,
6 Chung Kio Insurance Company after serving in the Philippines and Taiwan; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Tsui established their first office in 1972 and was
8 instrumental in establishing the industry locally; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Tsui, after retirement, decided to start his own insurance
10 agency and became a bridge for new immigrants to the local community through
11 his service earning the nickname of "Insurance Tsui"; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Tsui is a down to earth and sincere gentleman, always
13 seeking the best for his clientele and those who are in need; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. & Mrs. Tsui have contributed to many efforts in
2 supporting the work of the Chinese Association of Guam in various capacities; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Tsui served the Chinese Association of Guam as President
4 and worked tirelessly to provide a bridge for new Chinese immigrants to adjust,
5 adapt and appreciate living on Guam; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Mr. & Mrs. Tsui are devout Christians and are known as
7 founding members of the Chinese Church on Guam. Their belief system is shared
8 with thousands of Chinese Christians that their fundamental belief and faith in God
9 and sharing God’s love is their mission; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Tsui is a humble man, freely and happily sharing his
11 gifts, talents and resources with those in need, often offering English lessons to
12 many new immigrants and spending time as their translator, interpreter and guide;

14 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Tsui has shared his gifts of song with many church and
15 community choirs, and is also a songwriter and preacher of God’s love; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Tsui is an advocate for good health practices and exercise.
17 A sports enthusiast often practicing some form of exercise through swimming,
18 tennis, bowling or hiking; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Tsui is best known for his 30 year role in providing free
20 lessons in Tai Chi Chuan to hundreds of participants every weekend at Ypao Beach
21 Park; this gave him the 2005 honor of being named “The Most Inspirational
22 Athlete- *Manâmkô*” by the Governor’s Council on Physical Fitness and Sports;

25 together share the love of their children and in-laws: Eufemia T. & Gerald Lui and
