3 **WHEREAS,** Rosario L.G. Quitugua was born in Inarajan, Guam on October
4 11, 1953 to Mariano Duenas Leon Guerrero (deceased) and Anna Chargualaf Naputi
5 Leon Guerrero (deceased); and is one of thirteen (13) children. Rosario has four (4)
6 brothers: +Johnny, Rafael, Joseph, and Mariano; and eight (8) sisters: +Espresioca,
7 Gloria, Anita, Margaret, Winefreda +Lourdes, Bernadita, and Teresita; and

8 **WHEREAS,** Rosario L.G. Quitugua attended Inarajan Elementary School;
9 Inarajan Junior High School; and then graduated in 1972 from George Washington
10 High School; and

1 **WHEREAS**, on February 7, 2012 Rosario L.G. Quitugua married +Jose Cruz
2 Quitugua, and they were blessed with one (1) daughter, Victoria Quitugua; and a
3 grandson; and

4 **WHEREAS**, in 1970 Rosario L.G. Quitugua began her career as a Summer
5 Trainee with the Inarajan Commissioners Office; and after graduating from High
6 School, Rosario was hired as a Clerk I with the Department of Education, Vocational
7 Rehabilitation Division in 1973; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Rosario L.G. Quitugua's tenure with the Department of Education
9 spanned from 1973 to 1976 where she moved up in the ranks from a Clerk I to a Clerk
10 II and a Clerk III; and

11 **WHEREAS**, on February 14, 1977, Rosario L.G. Quitugua was hired at the
12 Guam Housing Corporation as a Clerk I; and thereafter moved up in the ranks to a
13 Clerk Typist, Trust Fund Clerk, Accounting Tech. I, Accounting Tech II, Accounting
14 Tech III and to her current position as Accountant Technician Supervisor; and

15 **WHEREAS**, duties and responsibilities of Rosario L.G. Quitugua with the
16 Guam Housing Corporation included supervision of Accounting Staff, and areas of
17 function such as payroll; benefits deductions; receivables; payables; taxes due; ledger;
18 journal; vouchers; and overall training of the Accounting Staff ; and

19 **WHEREAS**, with over forty (40) years of government service , Rosario L.G.
20 Quitugua's dedication to her work allowed her to rise through the ranks, holding
21 several key positions in the Accounting department of the Guam Housing
22 Corporation. Her willingness to take on additional duties, made her a prime example
23 of an "Exemplary Employee" ; and

24 **WHEREAS**, Rosario L.G. Quitugua trained her subordinates with patience;
25 and trained them on the technical knowledge of the job at hand. She was always
