WHEREAS, President Tsai graduated from the College of Law at the National Taiwan University in 1978; and, she went on to obtain a Master of Laws at Cornell University Law School in 1980, and a Ph.D. in law from the London School of Economics in 1984; and

WHEREAS, President Tsai then became a Law Professor at the School of Law of Soochow University and National Chengchi University, both in Taipei; and

WHEREAS, President Tsai has traditionally held a number of appointed governmental positions, serving on the Fair Trade Commission, the Copyright Commission, and the National Security Council; and

WHEREAS, President Tsai became the Chairperson of the Mainland Affairs Council in 2000, and she was elected in 2004 to serve as a Legislator-at-Large; and

WHEREAS, President Tsai ran for the office of President in 2015, winning the Presidency in 2016; and, she was inaugurated to serve as President of Taiwan in May 2016; and

WHEREAS, President Tsai has traditionally supported disadvantaged groups in society, and favors government action to increase employment, introducing incentives for youth, expanding public housing, and extending government-mandated childcare support, thereby serving with the goal of improving society as a whole; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina Trentai Kuåttro Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam, express a warm welcome and *Håfa Adai* to Her Excellency President Tsai Ing-Wen on her visit to Guam; and does further recognize and commend Her Excellency Tsai Ing-Wen on her goal to cultivate an atmosphere of humanitarianism, environmental protection, and sustainable development; and be it further

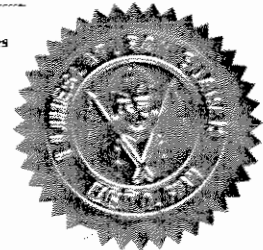
