3 **WHEREAS**, on June 25, 1975, the Korean Women's Association of Guam
4 (KWAG) was established as a non-profit organization, whose mission is to advocate
5 international goodwill and conformity, and to foster unity and solidarity among the local
6 Korean culture to remain strong throughout the community of Guam; and

7 **WHEREAS**, during the past forty-two (42) years, the Korean Women's
8 Association of Guam has been committed to addressing the humanitarian needs of our
9 island and abroad, and they have been acknowledged both locally and internationally
10 for their hard work, commitment, and the various outreach programs that offer aid to
11 those less fortunate, the elderly and sick, and those who have been victimized by
12 domestic violence; and

13 **WHEREAS**, as a non-profit organization, the source of funds of the KWAG
14 come from their membership fees, membership being open to any married Korean

1 woman residing on Guam; aid from the Korean Consulate General; the generous
2 donations from businesses around the island; and the annual Christmas Charity Gala
3 and Mother's Day festivities, which are hosted by the Association ; and

4 **WHEREAS**, over the years since its inception, the Korean Women's Association
5 of Guam has donated hugely to the Guam Memorial Hospital and it's Hospital
6 Volunteer Association; various charities such as: Alee Shelter; Guma Mami; the Korean
7 School of Guam; the Korean Senior Association of Guam; the American Cancer
8 Society; American Red Cross, Guam Chapter; the Salvation Army Guam Corps; the
9 Shriner's Hospital for Children; the Special Committee to Support the Homeless; the
10 HOPE Foundation, Scholarships to attend the University of Guam; Manna Fellowship
11 the Rigalu Foundation; Make-A-Wish Foundation; Sanctuary, Inc.; Island Girl Power;
12 the WORKS Foundation; and Kamalen Karidat; and
