BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I MINA'TRENTAI KUÁTTRO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN*:

WHEREAS, General Roderick R. Leon Guerrero, born in Tamuning, Guam on August 2, 1962, is the second child of six (6) siblings, born to Mrs. Virginia Artero and Dr. Wilfred Leon Guerrero, both from Asan; and

WHEREAS, General Leon Guerrero attended Saint Anthony School in Tamuning and graduated from Father Dueñas Memorial School in Mangilao in 1980. He later went on to receive his Bachelor of Science in Political Science at the University of Guam in 1989; and his Master of Science in Strategic Studies at the U.S. Army War College in Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, General Leon Guerrero enlisted in the Guam Army National Guard in 1985 and, after successfully completing the Army Reserve Officer Training Corps at the University of Guam, was commissioned as a 2nd Lieutenant on May 16, 1988. As a Commissioned Officer, his assignments included: Intelligence Officer; Executive Officer; Company Commander; Personnel Officer; Chief of Plans and

2 Recruiting and Retention Officer; Plans, Operations and Military Support Officer;

5 of the Joint Force Headquarters, Guam National Guard; and

6 **WHEREAS**, General Leon Guerrero was deployed to Afghanistan in support
7 of Operation Enduring Freedom with the first Embedded Training Team from the
8 Guam Army National Guard from February 2007 to May 2008; and

9 **WHEREAS**, General Leon Guerrero was awarded the following decorations
10 and badges for his outstanding performance and service: the Legion of Merit; the
11 Bronze Star Medal; the Meritorious Service Medal with three (3) Bronze Oak Leaf
12 Clusters; the Army Commendation Medal with five (5) Bronze Oak Leaf Clusters;
13 the Army Achievement Medal with two (2) Bronze Oak Leaf Clusters; the Army
14 Reserve Component Achievement Medal; the National Defense Service Medal with
15 Bronze Star; the Air Force Achievement Medal; the Afghanistan Campaign Medal;
16 the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal; the Humanitarian Service Medal; the
17 Army Service Ribbon; the Overseas Service Ribbon; the NATO Ribbon; the Combat
18 Action Badge; and the Parachutist Badge; and

19 **WHEREAS**, General Leon Guerrero was pinned to the rank of Brigadier
20 General on March 27, 2015, upon confirmation by unanimous consent during the
21 Executive Session of the U.S. Senate on June 23, 2015; and

22 **WHEREAS**, General Leon Guerrero was appointed by the Honorable Eddie
23 B. Calvo, *I Maga'låhen Guåhan*, in March 2015 and confirmed by *I Liheslatura* on
24 May 1, 2015, to serve as the Adjutant General of the Guam National Guard and
25 Director of the Department of Military Affairs; and

26 **WHEREAS**, General Leon Guerrero will be pinned the rank of major general,
27 authorized by the U.S. Air Force General Joseph L. Lengyel, Chief of National

1 Guard Bureau, which includes a federal recognition process and U.S. Senate
2 confirmation; and

3 **WHEREAS**, upon General Leon Guerrero’s promotion to major general, the
4 highest permanent rank during peacetime in the uniformed services, the island and
5 the people of Guam, and particularly the Guam National Guard, are deeply proud of
6 this historic achievement of a son of Guam; and

7 **WHEREAS**, General Leon Guerrero continues to serve his island and nation
8 with integrity and respect, and as an inspiration to his fellow officers, friends, and
9 family; now therefore be it

10 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Kuáttro na*
11 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
12 people of Guam, recognize, commend, and congratulate General Roderick R. Leon
13 Guerrero, Adjutant General, Guam National Guard, on his promotion to the rank of
14 major general, and does further express *Un Dångkulo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to him
15 for his leadership, accomplishments, and continued service to the United States of
16 America and our island community; and be it further

17 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on
18 Rules certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that
19 copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to General Roderick R. Leon Guerrero;
